### **SYNOPSIS**

Prohibits electronic printing of certain debit card information on certain sales receipts.

### **CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT**

As introduced.



1 AN ACT concerning the electronic printing of complete debit card  
2 numbers on certain sales receipts and amending P.L.2002, c.101.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Section 1 of P.L.2002, c.101 (C.56:11-42) is amended to  
8 read as follows:

9 1. No retail sales establishment shall print electronically more  
10 than the last five digits of a customer's credit card or debit card  
11 account number or the expiration date of that credit or debit card  
12 upon any sales receipt provided at the point of sale to the customer,  
13 except that the provisions of this section shall not apply to any  
14 sales receipt in which the sole means of recording the customer's  
15 credit card or debit card number is by handwriting or by an imprint  
16 or copy of the credit or debit card.

19 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2009.

22 STATEMENT

24 This bill amends section 1 of P.L.2002, c.101 (C.56:11-42) to  
25 prohibit a retail sales establishment from electronically printing  
26 more than the last five digits of a customer's debit card account  
27 number, or the expiration date of the customer's debit card, upon  
28 any sales receipt provided to the customer at the point of sale,  
29 except for any sales receipt in which the sole means of recording  
30 the customer's debit card number is by handwriting or by an imprint  
31 or copy of the customer's debit card.

32 Currently, a retail sales establishment is prohibited from  
33 electronically printing more than the last five digits of a customer's  
34 credit card account number, or the expiration date of the customer's  
35 credit card, upon any sales receipt provided to the customer at the  
36 point of sale, except for any sales receipt in which the sole means of  
37 recording the customer's credit card number is by handwriting or by  
38 an imprint or copy of the customer's credit card.

**EXPLANATION** – Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets **[thus]** in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

Matter underlined thus is new matter.
