SYNOPSIS

Exempts veterans' organizations from nonprofit corporation annual report filing fee.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

Introduced Pending Technical Review by Legislative Counsel.



1 AN ACT concerning veterans' organizations and certain nonprofit
2 corporation filing fees and supplementing Title 15A of the New
3 Jersey Statutes.

4
5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6 of New Jersey:

7
8 1. A veterans' organization which organizes as a corporation
9 under the "New Jersey Nonprofit Corporation Act," N.J.S.15A:1-1
10 et seq., shall be exempt from paying the annual report filing fee
11 required pursuant to subsection f. of N.J.S.15A:15-1, when filing
12 the annual report required pursuant to N.J.S.15A:4-5.

13 As used in this section, "veterans' organization" means the
14 American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, or other veterans'
15 organizations chartered under federal law, or any service foundation
16 of such an organization recognized in its bylaws.

18 2. This act shall take effect six months after the date of
19 enactment.

22 STATEMENT

24 This bill exempts veterans' organizations which organize as
25 corporations under the "New Jersey Nonprofit Corporation Act,"
26 N.J.S.A.15A:1-1 et seq., from paying the annual report filing fee.
27 Under current law, nonprofit corporations must pay a \$25 annual
28 report filing fee. Under the bill, veterans' organizations which
29 organize as nonprofit corporations must still file the annual report
30 required by N.J.S.A.15A:4-5, but are exempted from the filing fee.

31 The bill defines "veterans' organization" to mean the American
32 Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, or other veterans' organizations
33 chartered under federal law, or any service foundation of such an
34 organization recognized in its bylaws.
