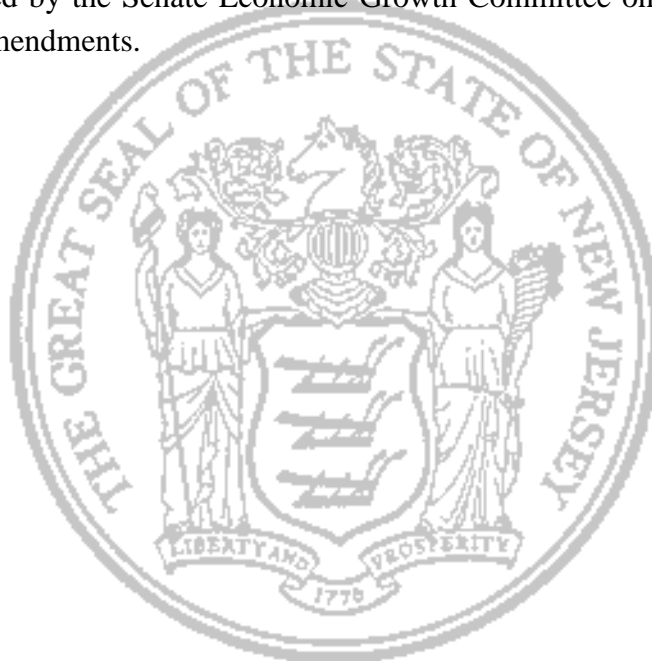

1 AN ACT authorizing counties to issue promotional labeling for
2 county agricultural products and supplementing Title 4 of the
3 Revised Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. A county, after consulting with the Department of
9 Agriculture ¹,¹ may create, adopt, and issue promotional labels to be
10 used on agricultural products to identify agricultural products,
11 either fresh or processed, that are produced in the county.

13 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
