

P.L. 2009, CHAPTER 99, *approved August 6, 2009*
Senate, No. 2770

1 AN ACT appropriating \$15,557,201 from the “Garden State Historic
2 Preservation Trust Fund,” the “2007 Historic Preservation
3 Fund,” and certain other historic preservation bonds funds, for
4 the purpose of providing grants, as awarded by the New Jersey
5 Historic Trust, for certain historic preservation projects, and
6 appropriating \$574,805 from certain historic preservation bond
7 funds for associated administrative expenses.

8
9 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
10 of New Jersey:

11
12 1. a. There is appropriated to the New Jersey Historic Trust the
13 following sums for the purpose of providing capital preservation
14 grants as listed in subsection b. of this section and historic site
15 management grants as listed in subsection c. of this section, as
16 awarded by the New Jersey Historic Trust, for historic preservation
17 projects approved as eligible for such funding:

18 (1) \$11,884,633 from the “Garden State Historic Preservation
19 Trust Fund” established pursuant to section 21 of the “Garden State
20 Preservation Trust Act,” P.L.1999, c.152 (C.13:8C-21);

21 (2) \$3,569,761 from the “2007 Historic Preservation Fund,”
22 established pursuant to section 20 of the “Green Acres, Farmland,
23 Blue Acres, and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 2007,”
24 P.L.2007, c.119;

25 (3) \$5,704 from the “1995 Historic Preservation Fund”
26 established pursuant to section 26 of the “Green Acres, Farmland
27 and Historic Preservation, and Blue Acres Bond Act of 1995,”
28 P.L.1995, c.204;

29 (4) \$17,135 from the “1992 Historic Preservation Fund”
30 established pursuant to section 25 of the “Green Acres, Clean
31 Water, Farmland and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 1992,”
32 P.L.1992, c.88; and

33 (5) \$79,968 from the “Cultural Centers and Historic
34 Preservation Fund” established pursuant to section 20 of the “New
35 Jersey Green Acres, Cultural Centers and Historic Preservation
36 Bond Act of 1987,” P.L.1987, c.265.

37 b. The following historic preservation projects are eligible for
38 funding in the form of capital preservation grants, as awarded by
39 the New Jersey Historic Trust, using moneys appropriated pursuant
40 to subsection a. of this section:

2 d. Any transfer of any funds, or change in project sponsor, site,
3 or type, listed in subsection b. or c. of this section shall require the
4 approval of the Joint Budget Oversight Committee or its successor.

5 e. To the extent that moneys remain available after the projects
6 listed in subsection b. or c. of this section are offered funding
7 pursuant thereto, any project of a local government unit or

1 qualifying tax exempt nonprofit organization that previously
2 received funding for historic preservation purposes appropriated or
3 reappropriated from any Green Acres bond act, any annual
4 appropriations act, or the Garden State Historic Preservation Trust
5 Fund, or that receives funding pursuant to this act shall be eligible
6 to receive additional funding, as determined by the New Jersey
7 Historic Trust, subject to the approval of the Joint Budget Oversight
8 Committee or its successor.

9 For the purposes of this subsection, "Green Acres bond act"
10 means P.L.2007, c.119, P.L.1995, c.204, P.L.1992, c.88, and
11 P.L.1987, c.265.

13 2. a. There is appropriated from the "2007 Historic
14 Preservation Fund," established pursuant to section 20 of the
15 "Green Acres, Farmland, Blue Acres, and Historic Preservation
16 Bond Act of 2007," P.L.2007, c.119, to the New Jersey Historic
17 Trust the sum of \$300,000 for the purpose of providing
18 organizational, administrative and other work and services,
19 including salaries, equipment, materials and services necessary to
20 administer the applicable provisions of this act.

21 b. There is appropriated from the "1992 Historic Preservation
22 Fund" established pursuant to section 25 of the "Green Acres, Clean
23 Water, Farmland and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 1992,"
24 P.L.1992, c.88, to the New Jersey Historic Trust the sum of
25 \$274,805 for the purpose of providing organizational,
26 administrative and other work and services, including salaries,
27 equipment, materials and services necessary to administer the
28 applicable provisions of this act.

29

30 3. a. Of the monies previously appropriated from the "1995
31 Historic Preservation Fund" established pursuant to section 26 of
32 the "Green Acres, Farmland and Historic Preservation, and Blue
33 Acres Bond Act of 1995," P.L.1995, c.204, the sum of \$5,704 is
34 cancelled due to project withdrawals, cancelled obligations, and
35 project cost savings and appropriated to the New Jersey Historic
36 Trust pursuant to paragraph (3) of subsection a. of section 1 of this
37 act.

38 b. Of the monies previously appropriated from the "1992
39 Historic Preservation Fund" established pursuant to section 25 of
40 the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and Historic Preservation
41 Bond Act of 1992," P.L. 1992, c. 88, the sum of \$17,135 is
42 cancelled due to project withdrawals, cancelled obligations, and
43 project cost savings and appropriated to the New Jersey Historic
44 Trust pursuant to paragraph (4) of subsection a. of section 1 of this
45 act.

46 c. Of the monies previously appropriated from the "Cultural
47 Centers and Historic Preservation Fund" established pursuant to
48 section 20 of the "New Jersey Green Acres, Cultural Centers and

1 Historic Preservation Bond Act of 1987,” P.L.1987, c.265, the sum
2 of \$79,968 is cancelled due to project withdrawals, cancelled
3 obligations, and project cost savings and appropriated to the New
4 Jersey Historic Trust pursuant to paragraph (5) of subsection a. of
5 section 1 of this act.

7 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

10 STATEMENT

11
12 The bill would appropriate \$15,557,201 to the New Jersey
13 Historic Trust for the purpose of providing grants, as awarded by
14 the New Jersey Historic Trust, for certain historic preservation
15 projects contained in this bill.

16 Of this funding, \$11,884,633 is from the “Garden State Historic
17 Preservation Trust Fund” established pursuant to the "Garden State
18 Preservation Trust Act," P.L.1999, c.152 (C.13:8C-21); \$3,569,761
19 is from the “2007 Historic Preservation Fund,” established pursuant
20 to the “Green Acres, Farmland, Blue Acres, and Historic
21 Preservation Bond Act of 2007,” P.L.2007, c.119; \$5,704 is from
22 the “1995 Historic Preservation Fund” established pursuant to the
23 “Green Acres, Farmland and Historic Preservation, and Blue Acres
24 Bond Act of 1995,” P.L.1995, c.204; \$17,135 is from the “1992
25 Historic Preservation Fund” established pursuant to the “Green
26 Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and Historic Preservation Bond Act
27 of 1992,” P.L.1992, c.88; and \$79,968 is from the “Cultural Centers
28 and Historic Preservation Fund” established pursuant to the “New
29 Jersey Green Acres, Cultural Centers and Historic Preservation
30 Bond Act of 1987,” P.L.1987, c.265.

31 The projects listed in this bill have been approved by the New
32 Jersey Historic Trust and the Garden State Preservation Trust.

33 Of the project approvals contained in this bill, the sum of
34 \$14,755,445 will be used to provide capital preservation grants, and
35 the sum of \$801,756 will be used to provide historic site
36 management grants. Capital preservation grants fund the
37 restoration, preservation, repair and rehabilitation of historic sites
38 for new or continued use by nonprofit organizations or county and
39 municipal governments. The properties must be listed or eligible
40 for listing in the State or National Register of Historical Places.
41 The historic site management grants support non-construction
42 activities such as long-term planning of operations and programs
43 including building assessments, accessibility, landscape plans, and
44 creating educational campaigns to increase public awareness.

45 The bill provides that any transfer of any funds to another
46 project, or change in project sponsor, site, or type, listed in the bill
47 would require the approval of the Joint Budget Oversight
48 Committee.

1 The bill also provides that to the extent that there are funds
2 remaining after those projects listed in this bill are offered funding,
3 the New Jersey Historic Trust, with the approval of the Joint Budget
4 Oversight Committee, may use those funds to provide additional
5 funding for historic preservation projects of local government units
6 or qualifying tax-exempt nonprofit organizations previously
7 approved for funding pursuant to various other laws or approved for
8 funding pursuant to this bill.

9 The bill also cancels certain prior appropriations totaling
10 \$102,807 for historic preservation projects which have been made
11 available due to project withdrawals, canceled obligations, and
12 project cost savings, thereby making those moneys available for
13 appropriation again to fund other historic preservation projects.

14 Lastly, this bill appropriates \$300,000 from the “2007 Historic
15 Preservation Fund” and \$274,805 from the “1992 Historic
16 Preservation Fund” for the purpose of providing funding for the
17 organizational, administrative and other work and services,
18 including salaries, equipment, materials and services necessary to
19 administer the applicable provisions of this bill.
