ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION No. 36

The Senate Health, Human Services and Senior Citizens Committee reports favorably Assembly Joint Resolution No. 36.

This joint resolution designates August of each year as “Immunization Awareness Month” in New Jersey in order to promote public awareness about the safety and effectiveness of immunizations and their importance for preventing disease and death. The joint resolution directs the Governor to annually issue a proclamation calling upon public officials and the citizens of the State to observe the month with appropriate activities and programs.

This resolution is identical to Senate Joint Resolution No. 33 (SCA) (S. Kean), which was also reported favorably on this date by this committee.
