The Senate Transportation Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 1220 with committee amendments.

This amended bill designates the highway ramp off of State Highway Route No. 23 at Alps Road in Wayne Township, which is located near the Property Owner League (P.O.L.) Fire Company No. 2 quarters, as the “Gregory F. Velardi, Sr., Ramp.”

Mr. Velardi joined P.O.L. Fire Company No. 2 in 1956 and has served his community for over 50 years as a volunteer firefighter, captain of the fire company, member of two building committees, and member of the Fair Committee. Mr. Velardi is also a Life Member and Trustee of P.O.L. Fire Company No. 2, as well as a Life Member of the New Jersey State Firemen’s Association and the New Jersey State Exempt Firemen’s Association. It is the request of Mr. Velardi’s fellow members of the fire company that the ramp be named in his honor.

The committee amended the bill to specify the responsibilities of private parties in funding the signs authorized by the bill.
