The Senate Health, Human Services and Senior Citizens Committee reports favorably a Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Resolution No. 65.

This committee substitute resolution expresses opposition to Iran's election to the United Nation's Commission on the Status of Women, and urges every member of New Jersey's Congressional delegation to voice opposition to the United Nation's decision to seat Iran on a commission whose stated mission is to promote the rights of women throughout the world.

This substitute resolution is similar to Assembly Resolution No. 94 (Angelini/Vainieri Huttle/Quijano), which is pending before the Assembly Human Services Committee.
