SYNOPSIS

Requires display of State vehicle abuse hotline bumper stickers on all State vehicles.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

As introduced.



1 AN ACT requiring the display of State vehicle abuse hotline bumper
2 stickers on all State vehicles and supplementing chapter 31 of
3 Title 52 of the Revised Statutes.

5 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. All vehicles purchased with funds appropriated by the State
9 for the use of any officer, department or institution of the State,
10 shall display a vehicle abuse hotline bumper sticker unless
11 specifically exempted by R.S.52:31-14 or other provision of law or
12 in writing by the State Treasurer pursuant to a State vehicular
13 assignment and use policy. The sticker shall contain a telephone
14 number, or such other information as the State Treasurer shall deem
15 necessary, through which complaints regarding potential misuse of
16 a State vehicle can be submitted. The State Treasurer shall
17 establish and maintain such a vehicle abuse complaint hotline. The
18 operation of a State vehicle without the required sticker shall
19 subject the operator to the penalty set forth in R.S.52:31-15.

21 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

25

26 This bill requires the display of State vehicle abuse hotline
27 stickers on all State vehicles, unless the display is exempt by law or
28 written policy of the State Treasurer. The bill would codify a
29 current requirement for the display of such stickers set forth in the
30 State vehicular assignment and use policy circular of the
31 Department of the Treasury, effective July 23, 2009.
