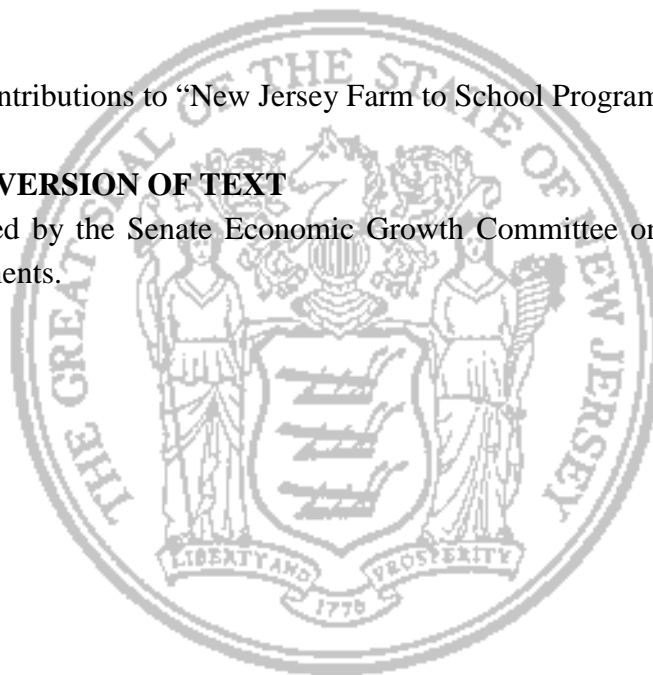

1 AN ACT concerning contributions to the ¹**[New Jersey “Farm to**
2 **School” program,]** “New Jersey Farm to School Program,”¹ and
3 supplementing Title 4 of the Revised Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. The Secretary of Agriculture may solicit and accept
9 contributions from private and public sources for the purpose of
10 providing support to help fund the ¹**[New Jersey “Farm to School”**
11 **program]** “New Jersey Farm to School Program,” established
12 pursuant to section 2 of P.L.2011, c.10 (C.4:10-25.2)¹, which
13 encourages schools to purchase produce from local farmers to
14 incorporate in school meals throughout the growing season, and to
15 increase the amount of local fresh produce available for
16 consumption by students during the school day.

18 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
