Notwithstanding the provisions of N.J.S.18A:55-2, or any 9 other law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, the commissioner shall 10 not direct the State treasurer to withhold funds payable by the State 11 to a school district based on the participation rate on any State assessment of the school district's students. 12 13 14 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 15 16 17 **STATEMENT** 18 This bill prohibits the Commissioner of Education from 19 20 withholding State school aid from a school district based on the 21 participation rate of its students on the State assessments. Recent 22 media articles indicate that the commissioner has suggested the 23 possibility of withholding State aid if a significant share of students 24 in a district do not take an assessment. This bill would prevent 25 districts from being penalized for matters beyond their control. 26 27 28 29 30 Prohibits withholding of State school aid based on student 31 participation rate on State assessments.
