1 AN ACT concerning State assessments and supplementing chapter
2 7C of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. a. As used in this section, “State assessment” means an
8 assessment required pursuant to State or federal law and
9 administered to all students in a specific grade level or subject area
10 and whose results are aggregated for analysis at the district, school,
11 or student subgroup level.

12 b. The Department of Education shall post and regularly update
13 on its website a list of all contractors, subcontractors, advisors, or
14 consultants employed or retained by the department for any work
15 associated with the administration, evaluation, monitoring of social
16 media for security breaches, grading, or ongoing development of
17 State assessments.

19 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
