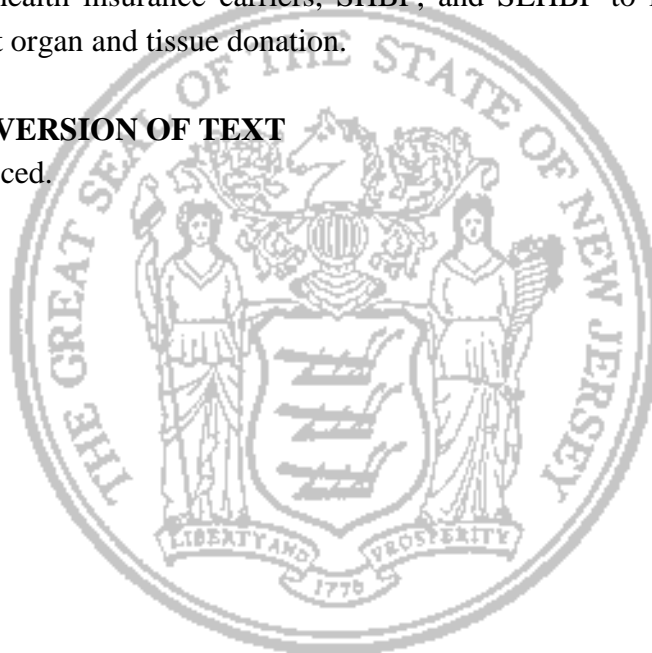

**SYNOPSIS**

Requires health insurance carriers, SHBP, and SEHBP to inform covered persons about organ and tissue donation.

2 information and supplementing P.L.1997, c.192 (C.26:2S-1 et  
3 al).

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. a. A carrier shall provide to subscribers written  
9 informational materials about organ and tissue donation and  
10 registration at each contract renewal. The materials shall be  
11 developed or approved by a federally designated organ procurement  
12 organization, and shall inform subscribers as to how to make an  
13 anatomical gift, including information on the registration of a gift in  
14 the Donate Life New Jersey registry.

15 b. For purposes of this section, "carrier," as defined in  
16 P.L.1997, c.192 (C.26:2S-1 et al.), shall also include the State  
17 Health Benefits Program and the School Employees' Health  
18 Benefits Program.

20 2. This act shall take effect on the 90<sup>th</sup> day next following  
21 enactment.

23 STATEMENT

25 This bill, which supplements the "Health Care Quality Act,"  
26 requires carriers to provide to subscribers written informational  
27 materials about organ and tissue donation and registration at each  
28 contract renewal. The materials shall be developed or approved by a  
29 federally designated organ procurement organization, and shall  
30 inform subscribers as to how to make an anatomical gift, including  
31 information on the registration of a gift in the Donate Life New  
32 Jersey registry.
