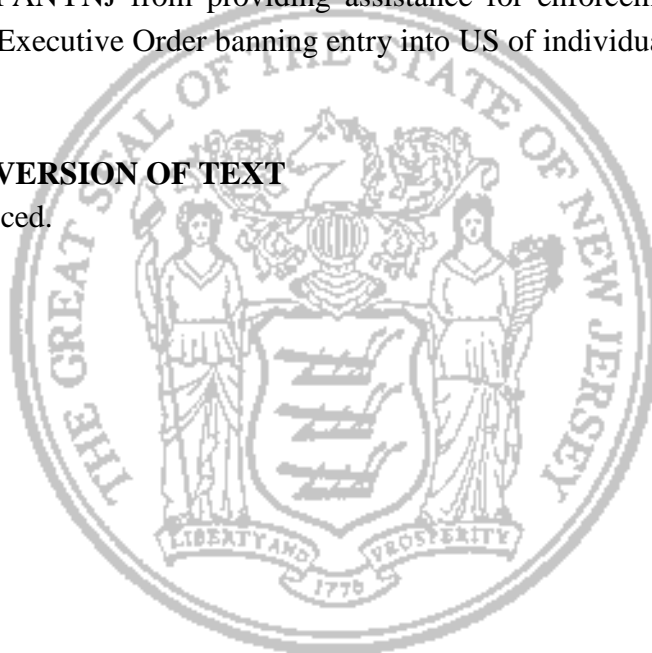

Prohibits PANYNJ from providing assistance for enforcement of January 27, 2017 US Executive Order banning entry into US of individuals from certain countries.

1 AN ACT concerning the Port Authority of New York and New  
2 Jersey and supplementing Title 32 of the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no  
8 employee or officer of the Port Authority of New York and New  
9 Jersey shall provide any aid, resources, assistance, or support to any  
10 federal employee or representative in enforcing the provisions of a  
11 United States Executive Order issued on January 27, 2017 regarding  
12 Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United  
13 States, nor may any resources or facilities of the Port Authority of  
14 New York and New Jersey be used for such purpose.

16 2. This act shall take effect upon the enactment into law by the  
17 State of New York of legislation having an identical effect, but if  
18 the State of New York shall have already enacted such legislation,  
19 then this act shall take effect immediately.

#### STATEMENT

23

24 This bill prohibits an employee or officer of the Port Authority  
25 of New York and New Jersey (Port Authority) from providing any  
26 aid, resources, assistance, or support to any federal employee or  
27 representative to enforce President Donald J. Trump's January 27,  
28 2017 Executive Order entitled "Protecting the Nation from Foreign  
29 Terrorist Entry into the United States" (executive order). The bill  
30 also prohibits the use of Port Authority resources or facilities to  
31 enforce the executive order.
