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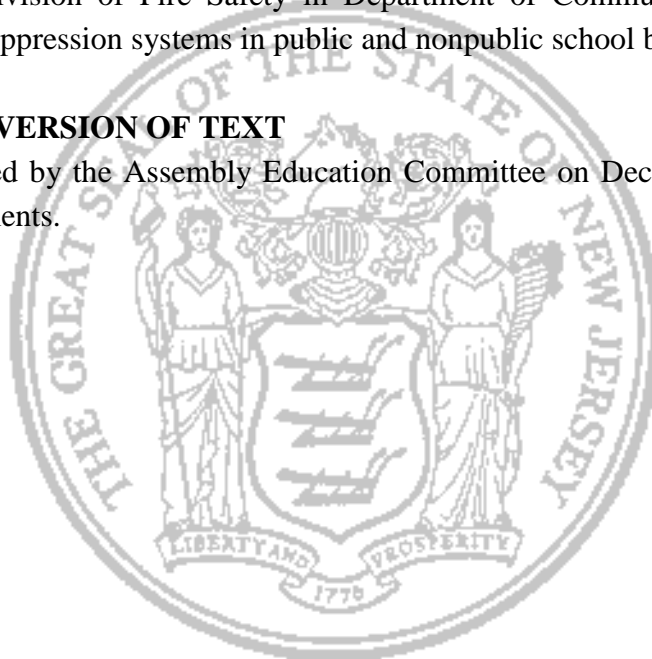

SYNOPSIS

Directs Division of Fire Safety in Department of Community Affairs to survey fire suppression systems in public and nonpublic school buildings.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

As reported by the Assembly Education Committee on December 4, 2017, with amendments.

1 AN ACT requiring a survey of fire suppression systems currently
2 installed in public and nonpublic school buildings.

4 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. a. The ¹**Department of Education** Division of Fire Safety in
8 the Department of Community Affairs¹ shall conduct a survey of fire
9 suppression systems in all public and nonpublic school buildings in the
10 State and shall provide those results to the ¹**Division of Fire Safety in**
11 **the Department of Community Affairs** Department of Education¹.

12 The survey shall include the following information for each building:

13 (1) whether a fire suppression system is installed and operational;

14 (2) the year in which an existing fire suppression system was
15 installed, and any year in which additional piping or standpipes were
16 added to the system or an additional system was installed in the same
17 structure;

18 (3) the cost of curing any defect if an installed fire suppression
19 system is not fully operational; and

20 (4) the cost of a reinstallation or annual maintenance of a fire
21 suppression system that is inadequate or not fully operational.

22 b. The survey required pursuant to subsection a. of this section
23 shall be ¹**completed by the Department of Education, and**¹
24 published by the Division of Fire Safety and posted on its Internet
25 website, no later than the first day of the third January next following
26 the effective date of P.L. , c. (C.) (pending before the
27 Legislature as this bill).

29 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
