SYNOPSIS

Amends Fiscal Year 2018 annual appropriation act to ensure involuntarily furloughed State employees receive retroactive salary payments for State government budget shut down.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

1 AN ACT to amend "An Act making appropriations for the support of
2 the State Government and the several public purposes for the
3 fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 and regulating the disbursement
4 thereof," approved July 4, 2017 (P.L.2017, c.99).

6 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and the General Assembly of the
7 State of New Jersey:

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9 1. The following language provision is added to P.L.2017,
10 c.99, the annual appropriation act for fiscal year 2018:

12 97. Notwithstanding any provision of law, rule, regulation, or order to the
13 contrary, for the period of emergency established pursuant to Executive Order
14 No. 228 issued by the Governor on June 30, 2017, any involuntarily
15 furloughed Executive branch, Judicial branch, or Legislative branch employee
16 shall promptly receive their full salary or wage payment despite the shut down
17 of State programs and functions during that period of emergency.

19 2. Section 97 of P.L.2017, c.99, the annual appropriation act for
20 fiscal year 2018 is amended to read as follow:

21 **[97.]** 98. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be
22 retroactive to July 1, 2017.

24 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be retroactive
25 to July 1, 2017.

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28 STATEMENT

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30 This bill amends the annual appropriation act for fiscal year 2018
31 to ensure that all involuntarily furloughed State employees under
32 the three day implementation of the Governor's Executive Order
33 No. 228 shall receive their salary or wage payments for the period
34 of State government shut down from July 1 through July 3, 2017.
