SYNOPSIS

Requires school districts to incorporate age-appropriate sexual abuse and assault awareness and prevention education in grades preschool through 12 as part of New Jersey Student Learning Standards in Comprehensive Health and Physical Education.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

8 1. Each school district shall incorporate age-appropriate sexual 9 abuse and assault awareness and prevention education in grades 10 preschool through 12 as part of the district's implementation of the ¹[Core Curriculum Content] <u>New Jersey Student Learning</u>¹ 11 Standards in Comprehensive Health and Physical Education. ³ The 12 Commissioner of Education ¹, in consultation 2 with 2 the New 13 Jersey Coalition Against Sexual Assault, Prevent Child Abuse New 14 Jersey, and other entities with relevant expertise,¹ shall ¹[provide 15 school districts with <u>develop</u>¹ age-appropriate sample learning 16 activities and resources ¹[designed] . The commissioner shall 17 provide the material to school districts¹ to implement this 18 requirement.] ⁴[The Department of Children and Families, in 19 consultation with the] The⁴ Commissioner of Education, ⁴in 20 consultation with the Department of Children and Families,⁴ the 21 22 New Jersey Coalition Against Sexual Assault, Prevent Child Abuse 23 New Jersey, the New Jersey Children's Alliance, and other entities with relevant expertise, shall provide school districts with age-24 appropriate sample learning activities and resources.³ 25 26

27 2. A teaching staff member may satisfy in each professional
28 development cycle one or more hours of the professional
29 development requirement established by the State Board of
30 Education through participation in training programs on sexual
31 abuse and assault awareness and prevention.

33 3. This act shall take effect ²[immediately and section 1 shall first 34 apply to the 2018-2019 school year] <u>in the first full school year</u> 35 following the date of enactment².
