Requires public utility to charge veterans' organization residential rate for service delivered to property at which veterans' organization primarily operates.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
of New Jersey:

7 1. a. As used in P.L. , c. (C.) (pending before the8 Legislature as this bill):

9 "Armed forces" means the air, land, and sea forces established by10 State or federal law.

"Public utility" shall have the same meaning as provided inR.S.48:2-13.

¹³ "Veterans' organization" means an organization dedicated to ¹⁴ serving the needs of veterans of the armed forces that: is chartered ¹⁵ under federal law, qualifies as a tax exempt organization under ¹<u>paragraph (19) of</u>¹ subsection (c) of section 501 of the federal Internal ¹⁷ Revenue Code of 1986, 26 U.S.C. s.501 $^{1}(c)(19)^{1}$, or that is organized ¹⁸ as a corporation under the "New Jersey Nonprofit Corporation Act," ¹⁹ N.J.S.15A:1-1 et seq.

b. Notwithstanding any law, rule, regulation, or order to the contrary, a public utility shall charge a veterans' organization a residential rate for service delivered to the property at which the veterans' organization primarily operates, if the residential rate is lower than the commercial rate for service at that property.

c. A public utility, in consultation with the Board of Public
Utilities, shall establish a reasonable procedure by which an
organization may certify itself as a veterans' organization with the
public utility for the purposes of subsection b. of this section.
