The Assembly Transportation and Independent Authorities Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 3576.

As reported, this bill reduces the speed limit on Route 130 near Burlington City High School and the Wilbur Watts Intermediate School in Burlington City. The speed limit is reduced to 25 miles per hour on the portions of Route 130 that are directly adjacent to the schools. The speed limit is reduced to 35 miles per hour on the portions of Route 130 approaching the newly reduced speed limit zone. The fine for speeding on the portions of Route 130 designated under the bill is set at triple the typical fine for speeding.

As reported, Assembly Bill No. 3576 is identical to Senate Bill No. 1484, which was also reported by the committee on this date.
