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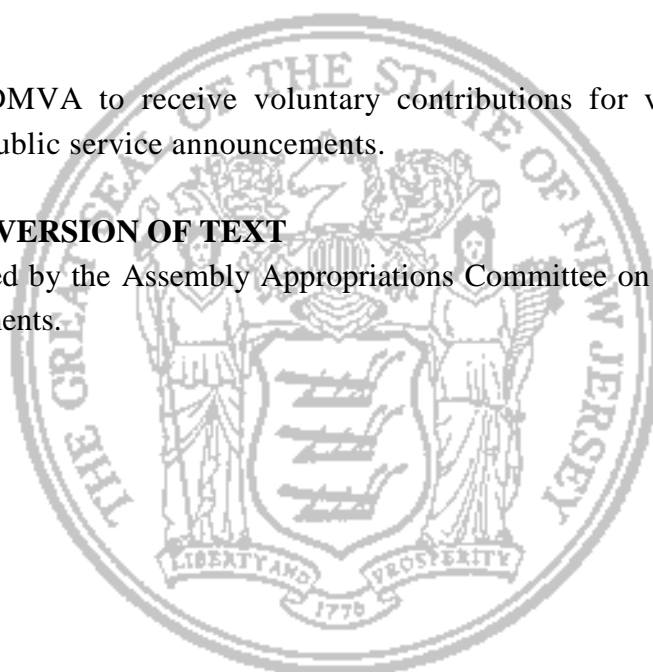

Permits DMVA to receive voluntary contributions for veteran suicide prevention public service announcements.

1 AN ACT permitting the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs
 2 to ¹**["raise funds"]** accept moneys¹ for veteran suicide prevention
 3 public service announcements and supplementing chapter 13 of
 4 Title 38A of the New Jersey Statutes.

 6 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
 7 *of New Jersey:*

 9 1. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs shall be
 10 permitted to ¹**["raise money through contributions"]** accept moneys
 11 received by the department as gifts, grants, or donations¹ from the
 12 public and private sectors for the purpose of public service
 13 announcements for the prevention of veteran suicide.

14 ¹**["Revenues"]** Moneys¹ received by the department pursuant to
 15 this section shall be deposited into a special nonlapsing fund
 16 maintained by the State Treasurer. Moneys credited to such
 17 account shall be appropriated ¹**["and"]**¹ solely to fund public service
 18 announcements for the prevention of veteran suicide.

 20 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
