### **SUMMARY**

million.

## Office of Legislative Services Estimate

- The Office of Legislative Services (OLS) estimates that the Greater Wildwoods Tourism Improvement and Development Authority will receive an additional \$4 million per year under this bill for a period of 15 years from FY 2019 through FY 2033, for a total fiscal impact of \$60 million. This represents an expenditure increase to the State and a revenue increase for the authority.
- The bill provides for a supplemental appropriation of \$4 million in FY 2019.

# **BILL DESCRIPTION**

This bill requires an appropriation from the State General Fund to the Greater Wildwoods Tourism Improvement and Development Authority of \$4 million per year from FY 2020 through FY 2033, and makes a supplemental appropriation of \$4 million to the authority for FY 2019. The annual appropriation is to be used for boardwalk construction, maintenance, reconstruction, and repair.

This represents an expenditure increase to the State and a revenue increase for the authority. The supplemental appropriation will directly provide \$4 million in FY 2019.
