SYNOPSIS

Requires suspension of school bus endorsement on driver's license for certain number of motor vehicle moving violations in certain time period.

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1 AN ACT concerning school bus endorsements and supplementing 2 Title 39 of the Revised Statutes. 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. a. For the purposes of this section: 8 "Chief administrator" means the Chief Administrator of the New 9 Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission. 10 "Commercial motor vehicle" shall have the same meaning as 11 provided in section 3 of P.L.1990, c.103 (C.39:3-10.11). "Motor vehicle moving violation" means any violation of the 12 motor vehicle laws of this State or any other jurisdiction for which 13 vehicle points are assessed by the chief administrator pursuant to 14 15 section 1 of P.L.1982, c.43 (C.39:5-30.5) or any violation of the 16 motor vehicle laws of any other jurisdiction for which vehicle 17 points would be assessed if that violation had occurred in this State. 18 "Non-commercial motor vehicle" shall have the same meaning as provided in section 3 of P.L.1990, c.103 (C.39:3-10.11). 19 20 b. The chief administrator shall suspend the school bus 21 endorsement of a person for 90 days following the date of the last 22 conviction if the person is convicted of three or more motor vehicle 23 moving violations in a three-year period or accumulates six or more 24 motor vehicle penalty points while operating a commercial motor 25 vehicle or non-commercial motor vehicle. 26 The chief administrator shall immediately notify the c. 27 Commissioner of Education of the suspension of a school bus 28 driver's school bus endorsement pursuant to subsection b. of this 29 section. 30 d. Upon notification from the chief administrator pursuant to 31 subsection c. of this section, the Commissioner of Education shall 32 immediately notify the board of education that employs the school 33 bus driver or the contractor that employs the school bus driver that 34 the school bus driver's school bus endorsement has been suspended pursuant to subsection b. of this section. If a board of education or 35 36 a contractor that employs the school bus driver is notified by the 37 commissioner that the school bus driver's school bus endorsement has been suspended, the employing board of education or 38 39 contractor, within 24 hours of the notification, shall provide a 40 statement to the Department of Education verifying that the school 41 bus driver no longer operates a school bus for the board or 42 contractor. 43 e. Prior to the reinstatement of any school bus endorsement 44 suspended pursuant to subsection b. of this section, the chief 45 administrator shall require the person to complete a defensive 46 driving course approved by the chief administrator and may require the person to fulfill any other requirement that the chief 47

48 administrator deems appropriate.

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1 f. This section shall apply to convictions that occur after the 2 effective date of P.L. , c. (C.) (pending before the 3 Legislature as this bill). 4 5 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 6 7 8 **STATEMENT** 9 10 This bill requires the Chief Administrator ("chief administrator") 11 of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission to suspend the 12 school bus endorsement on a person's driver's license for 90 days if the person is convicted of three or more motor vehicle moving 13 14 violations in a three-year period or accumulates six or more motor 15 vehicle penalty points while operating a commercial motor vehicle 16 or non-commercial motor vehicle. The chief administrator is 17 required to immediately notify the Commissioner of Education of 18 the suspension and the Commissioner of Education is required to 19 immediately notify the school bus driver's employer of the 20 suspension. Once notified, the employing board of education or 21 contractor is required to notify the Department of Education that the 22 person no longer operates a school bus for the board or contractor. 23 Prior to the reinstatement of a school bus endorsement suspended 24 pursuant to the bill, the person is required to complete a defensive 25 driving course. The chief administrator is authorized to provide 26 additional requirements for reinstatement of the school bus 27 endorsement. 28 The bill applies to convictions for motor vehicle moving

29 violations that occur after the effective date of the bill.
