The chief administrator shall suspend the school bus 22 endorsement of a person for 90 days following the date of the last conviction¹, or upon notification of an out-of-State conviction, 23 whichever date is later in time,¹ if the person is convicted of three 24 or more motor vehicle moving violations in a three-year period or 25 accumulates six or more motor vehicle penalty points while 26 27 operating a commercial motor vehicle or non-commercial motor vehicle. 28 The chief administrator shall ¹[immediately]¹ notify the 29 c. Commissioner of Education of the suspension of a school bus 30 driver's school bus endorsement pursuant to subsection b. of this 31 section ¹ within one business day following the date of the 32 suspension¹. 33 34 d. bus driver's school bus endorsement has been suspended, the employing board of education¹, nonpublic school,¹ or contractor, within 24 hours of the notification, shall provide a statement to the Department of Education verifying that the school bus driver no longer operates a school bus for the board¹, nonpublic school,¹ or contractor.

e. Prior to the reinstatement of any school bus endorsement
suspended pursuant to subsection b. of this section, the chief
administrator shall require the person to complete a defensive
driving course approved by the chief administrator and may require
the person to fulfill any other requirement that the chief
administrator deems appropriate.
