SYNOPSIS

Permits school district of residence to provide aid in-lieu-of transportation to pupil attending Marine Academy of Science and Technology provided certain conditions are met.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation to the Marine Academy of
2 Science and Technology and amending P.L.1983, c.341.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. Section 6 of P.L.1983, c.341 (C.18A:54C-7) is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 6. Transportation for pupils attending the Marine Academy of
10 Science and Technology shall be provided by the district in which
11 the pupil resides; except that in the case of a pupil whose school
12 district of residence is not located in the county in which the
13 academy is located and the pupil resides more than 40 miles from
14 the academy, then the parent, guardian, or other person having legal
15 custody of the pupil shall be eligible to receive the amount
16 determined pursuant to section 2 of P.L.1981, c.57 (C.18A:39-1a).
17 (cf: P.L.1983, c.341, s.6)

19 2. This act shall take effect on July 1 of the first full school
20 year following the date of enactment.

23 STATEMENT

25 This bill revises the requirements for providing pupil
26 transportation to students attending the Marine Academy of Science
27 and Technology which is a county vocational school located in
28 Monmouth County. Currently, the school district in which a
29 student resides is required to provide transportation if a student
30 resides more than two and one-half miles from his county
31 vocational school of attendance, regardless of the distance to the
32 county vocational school or the cost of the transportation. This bill
33 would continue to require resident school districts to provide
34 transportation to all of their pupils attending the Marine Academy
35 of Science and Technology, except in the case of students who
36 reside outside of Monmouth County and more than 40 miles from
37 the academy. In this case the student's parent or guardian would be
38 eligible to receive the aid-in-lieu-of transportation amount, which in
39 the 2018-2019 school year is \$1,000.
