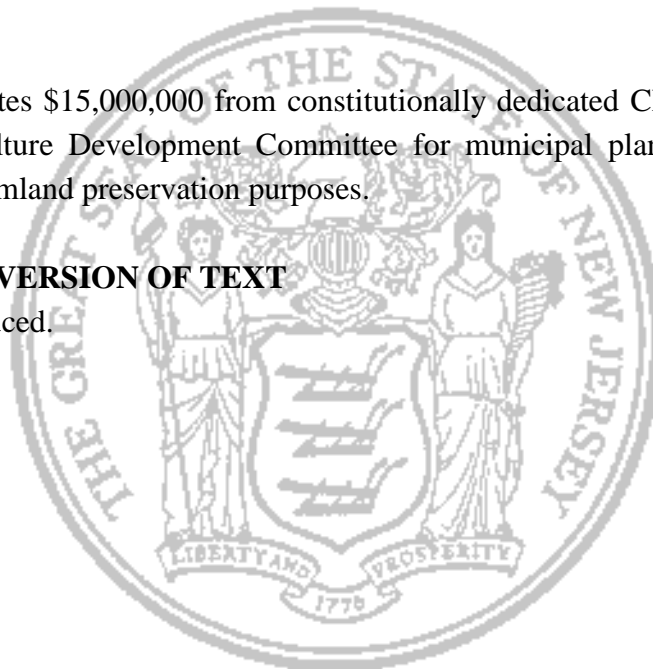

1 AN ACT appropriating \$15,000,000 from constitutionally dedicated
2 corporation business tax revenues to the State Agriculture
3 Development Committee for municipal planning incentive grants
4 for farmland preservation purposes.

6 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
7 of New Jersey:

9 1. a. There is appropriated to the State Agriculture
10 Development Committee the sum of \$15,000,000 from dedicated
11 corporation business tax revenues pursuant to Article VIII, Section
12 II, paragraph 6 of the State Constitution in the “Preserve New
13 Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund,” established pursuant to section
14 8 of the “Preserve New Jersey Act,” P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-50),
15 for the purpose of providing municipal planning incentive grants
16 pursuant to section 1 of P.L.1999, c.180 (C.4:1C-43.1) and
17 approved as eligible for such funding pursuant to subsection b. of
18 this section.

19 b. The following project are eligible for funding with the
20 monies appropriated pursuant to subsection a. of this section:

2 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the “Preserve
3 New Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund,” established pursuant to
4 section 8 of the “Preserve New Jersey Act,” P.L.2016, c.12
5 (C.13:8C-50), the sum of \$15,000,000 to implement the provisions
6 of this act.

8 3. The expenditure of the sums appropriated by this act is
9 subject to the provisions and conditions of P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-
10 43 et seq.), P.L.1999, c.180 (C.4:1C-43.1), P.L.1999, c.152
11 (C.13:8C-1 et seq.), and P.L.1983, c.32 (C.4:1C-11 et seq.), as
12 appropriate.

14 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

19 This bill would appropriate \$15,000,000 to the State Agriculture
20 Development Committee (SADC) for municipal planning incentive
21 grants pursuant to a program established by P.L.1999, c.180
22 (C.4:1C-43.1) for farmland preservation purposes.

23 This funding is from constitutionally dedicated corporation
24 business tax revenues in the “Preserve New Jersey Farmland
25 Preservation Fund,” established pursuant to section 8 of the
26 “Preserve New Jersey Act,” P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-50).

27 This bill would provide grants to 20 municipalities. The
28 appropriation and projects listed in this bill have been approved by
29 the SADC and the Garden State Preservation Trust.
