8	marks the 70th anniversary of Israel's independence; and
9	WHEREAS, The modern State of Israel was born out of the ashes of the
10	Holocaust and World War II where the death of six million Jews
11	did not eliminate the will of a people to seek dignity in life and a
12	place of respect and recognition among the people of the civilized
13	world; and
14	WHEREAS, Israel, from its inception, has faced hostility and has
15	endured terrorist attacks which have indiscriminately killed many
16	innocent men, women, and children; and
17	WHEREAS, Despite hostility and conflicts, the people of Israel have
18	built a strong nation and forged a dynamic society, creating a
19	unique and vital economic, political, cultural, and intellectual life
20	for its citizens; and
21	WHEREAS, In its 70 years of statehood, Israel has established a
22	modern parliamentary democracy, becoming one of the most
23	successful democracies in the Middle East, and provided to all its
24	citizens and residents opportunity through the highest standards of

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. The Governor and the Legislature <sup>1</sup> [recognizes] recognize<sup>1</sup> the historic significance of the 70th anniversary of the establishment of the sovereign and independent modern State of Israel and commend the people of Israel for their remarkable achievements in building a new state and a pluralistic democratic society in the Middle East. The Governor and the Legislature of the State of New Jersey reaffirm the bonds of friendship and cooperation which have existed between New Jersey and Israel for seven decades and recommit to working with Israel in its quest for peace with its neighbors and the countries in the region.

2. The Governor and the Legislature extend congratulations to the State of Israel and its citizens on the 70th anniversary of its establishment.

3. Copies of this resolution, as filed with the Secretary of State, shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the General Assembly or the Secretary of the Senate to Israel's ambassador to the United States and its ambassador to the United Nations.

4. This joint resolution shall take effect immediately.
