1 AN ACT concerning amended certificates of birth <sup>2</sup>, designated as Babs Siperstein Law,<sup>2</sup> and amending P.L.1984, c.191. 2 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. Section 1 of P.L.1984, c.191 (C.26:8-40.12) is amended to 8 read as follows: 9 1. The State registrar shall issue an amended certificate of birth to a person born in this State who [undergoes sex reassignment 10 surgery and ] requests an amended certificate of birth which shows 11 the <sup>1</sup>[sex] <u>gender</u><sup>1</sup> and, <u>if applicable, the</u> name of the person as it 12 has been changed. <sup>1</sup>[<u>The application may be submitted on the</u> 13 14 person's behalf by a parent or guardian, if the person is a minor. ]<sup>1</sup> 15 The State registrar shall issue the amended certificate of a. birth upon receipt of: (1) a certified copy of an order from a court 16 17 of competent jurisdiction which indicates that the name of the 18 person has been changed, if the person has changed his or her name; and (2) a [medical certificate from] form provided by the State 19 registrar and completed by the <sup>1</sup>[person's licensed [physician] 20 health care provider person, or the person's guardian,<sup>1</sup> which 21 <sup>1</sup>[indicates]<sup>1</sup> [the sex of the person has been changed by surgical 22 23 procedure] <sup>1</sup>[that the person has undergone clinically appropriate 24 treatment for the purpose of gender transition, based on 25 contemporary medical standards, or that the person has an intersex condition.] affirms the following language: "I, (petitioner's full 26 name), hereby attest under penalty of perjury that the request for a 27 28 change in gender to (female, male, or undesignated/non-binary) is 29 to conform my legal gender to my gender identity and is not for any fraudulent purpose."1 30 b. The amended certificate of birth shall be of the same general 31 type as the original certificate of birth, <sup>1</sup>[but] and<sup>1</sup> shall not be 32 33 marked as amended. c. When an amended certificate of birth is issued, the State 34 registrar shall notify the appropriate local registrar of vital statistics 35 who shall enter the amended certificate in his local record and place 36 37 his copy of the original certificate under seal. 38 The State [register] registrar shall place the original d. certificate of birth and all papers pertaining to the amended 39

The seal shall not be broken except 1 2 by order of a court of competent jurisdiction, or upon the request of 3 the person who is the subject of the certificate of birth, or the parent 4 or guardian, if the person is a minor. 5 Thereafter, whenever a certified copy of the certificate of birth is prepared, it shall be made from the amended certificate of birth 6 7 except when an order of a court of competent jurisdiction requires 8 that a certified copy be made of the original certificate of birth. 9 e. In the case of a resident of this State who was born in another state or in a foreign jurisdiction, if such other state or 10 foreign jurisdiction requires a court order in order to amend a 11 certificate of birth to reflect a change in <sup>1</sup>[sex] gender<sup>1</sup>, a court in 12 this State shall have jurisdiction to issue <sup>1</sup>[such]<sup>1</sup> an order 13 <sup>1</sup>declaring a person's gender upon receipt of a statement affirming 14 under penalty of perjury that the request for a declaration of female, 15 male, or undesignated/non-binary gender is to conform with gender 16 17 identity and not for any fraudulent purpose<sup>1</sup>. [e.] <u>f.</u> The fee for issuing the amended certificate of birth is 18 19 \$6.00. (cf: P.L.1984, c.191, s.1) 20 21 22 2.
