This bill would authorize the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) to expend additional sums to make loans for environmental infrastructure projects for Fiscal Year 2019.

In August 2018, P.L.2018, c.84 was enacted into law, which authorized the NJEIT to expend up to \$810.6 million, and any unexpended balances from previous authorizations, to provide lowinterest and market-rate loans to project sponsors (primarily local governments, public authorities, or public water utilities) for a portion of the total costs of 119 eligible environmental

- 46 infrastructure projects for Fiscal Year 2019. This included 70
- 47 projects from the "Storm Sandy and State Fiscal Year 2019 Clean

Sandy and State Fiscal Year 2019 Drinking Water Project Eligibility List." The NJEIT was also authorized under P.L.2018, c.84 to provide supplemental loans to five clean water projects that received loans in the past and which require supplemental loans in order to meet actual costs.

6 This bill would amend the lists of environmental infrastructure 7 projects for which the NJIB is authorized to make loans in 8 P.L.2018, c.84 to include new projects and remove certain projects. 9 Thus, under the bill, the NJIB would be authorized to expend up to 10 \$822.9 million, and any unexpended balances from previous 11 authorizations, to provide loans to project sponsors for a total of 12 134 eligible environmental infrastructure projects for Fiscal Year 13 2019. This would include 84 projects on the "Storm Sandy and 14 State Fiscal Year 2019 Clean Water Project Eligibility List" and 47 15 projects on the "Storm Sandy and State Fiscal Year 2019 Drinking 16 Water Project Eligibility List." The NJIB would also be authorized 17 to make supplemental loans to three clean water environmental 18 infrastructure projects.

In addition, certain projects have been removed from the list of projects for which the NJIB is authorized to make loans either because they have already received long-term funding or because the projects will not be ready to receive funding before the end of Fiscal Year 2019 under NJIB program requirements.
