1 **AN ACT** authorizing the expenditure of additional funds by the New
2 Jersey Infrastructure Bank for the purpose of making loans to
3 eligible project sponsors to finance a portion of the cost of
4 construction of environmental infrastructure projects, and
5 amending P.L.2018, c.84.

7 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
8 *of New Jersey:*

9

10 1. Section 1 of P.L.2018, c.84 is amended to read as follows:

11 1. a. The New Jersey Infrastructure Bank, established pursuant
12 to P.L.1985, c.334 (C.58:11B-1 et seq.), is authorized to expend the
13 aggregate sum of up to **[\$810.6]** \$822.9 million and any
14 uncommitted balance of the aggregate expenditures authorized
15 pursuant to section 1 of P.L.2000, c.93, section 1 of P.L.2001,
16 c.224, section 1 of P.L.2002, c.71, section 1 of P.L.2003, c.159,
17 section 1 of P.L.2004, c.110, section 1 of P.L.2005, c.197, section 1
18 of P.L.2006, c.67, section 1 of P.L.2007, c.140, section 1 of
19 P.L.2008, c.67, section 1 of P.L.2009, c.101, section 1 of P.L.2010,
20 c.62, section 1 of P.L.2011, c.95, section 1 of P.L.2012, c.38,
21 section 1 of P.L.2013, c.94, section 1 of P.L.2014, c.26, section 1 of
22 P.L.2015, c.107, and section 1 of P.L.2016, c.31 as amended by
23 P.L.2017, c.13, and section 1 of P.L.2017, c.142 as amended by
24 P.L.2017, c.327, for the purpose of making loans, to the extent
25 sufficient funds are available, to or on behalf of local government
26 units or public water utilities (hereinafter referred to as "project
27 sponsors") to finance all or a portion of the cost of construction of
28 environmental infrastructure projects listed in sections 2 and 4 of
29 **[this act]** P.L.2018, c.84, as amended by P.L. , c. (pending
30 before the Legislature as this bill).

31 b. The trust is authorized to increase the aggregate sums
32 specified in subsection a. of this section by:

33 (1) the amounts of capitalized interest and the bond issuance
34 expenses as provided in subsection b. of section 7 of **[this act]**
35 P.L.2018, c.84, as amended by P.L. , c. (pending before the
36 Legislature as this bill);

37 (2) the amounts of reserve capacity expenses and debt service
38 reserve fund requirements as provided in subsection c. of section 7
39 of **[this act]** P.L.2018, c.84, as amended by P.L. , c. (pending
40 before the Legislature as this bill);

41 (3) the interest earned on amounts deposited for project costs
42 pending their distribution to project sponsors as provided in

15 by P.L. , c. (pending before the Legislature as this bill).

16 c. (1) Of the sums made available to the trust from the “Water
17 Supply Trust Fund” established pursuant to subsection a. of section
18 15 of the "Water Supply Bond Act of 1981" (P.L.1981, c.261)
19 pursuant to P.L.1997, c.223, the trust is authorized to transfer such
20 amounts to the Department of Environmental Protection as needed
21 for drinking water project loans pursuant to the “Safe Drinking
22 Water Act Amendments of 1996,” Pub.L.104-182, and any
23 amendatory and supplementary acts thereto (hereinafter referred to
24 as the "Federal Safe Drinking Water Act"), under terms and
25 conditions established by the Commissioner of Environmental
26 Protection and trust, and approved by the State Treasurer, which
27 loans shall be jointly administered by the trust and department.

28 (2) Of the sums appropriated to the trust from the "Wastewater
29 Treatment Trust Fund" established pursuant to section 15 of the
30 "Wastewater Treatment Bond Act of 1985," (P.L.1985, c.329)
31 pursuant to P.L.1987, c.198, the trust is authorized to transfer such
32 amounts as needed to the Clean Water State Revolving Fund
33 established pursuant to section 1 of P.L.2009, c.77 for the purposes
34 of issuing loans or providing the State match as required for the
35 award of the capitalization grants made available to the State for
36 clean water projects pursuant to the "Water Quality Act of 1987"
37 (33 U.S.C. s.1251 et seq.), and any amendatory and supplementary
38 acts thereto (hereinafter referred to as the "Federal Clean Water
39 Act").

40 (3) Of the sums appropriated to the trust from the "1992
41 Wastewater Treatment Trust Fund" established pursuant to section
42 27 of the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and Historic
43 Preservation Bond Act of 1992" (P.L.1992, c.88) pursuant to
44 P.L.1996, c.86, the trust is authorized to transfer such amounts as
45 needed to the Clean Water State Revolving Fund for the purpose of
46 providing the State match as required for the award of the

1 capitalization grants made available to the State for clean water
2 projects pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act.

3 (4) Of the sums appropriated to the trust from the "Stormwater
4 Management and Combined Sewer Overflow Abatement Fund"
5 created pursuant to section 14 of the "Stormwater Management and
6 Combined Sewer Overflow Abatement Bond Act of 1989"
7 (P.L.1989, c.181) pursuant to P.L.1998, c.87, the trust is authorized
8 to transfer such amounts as needed to the Clean Water State
9 Revolving Fund for the purpose of providing the State match as
10 required for the award of the capitalization grants made available to
11 the State for clean water projects pursuant to the Federal Clean
12 Water Act.

13 (5) Of the sums appropriated to the trust from the "2003 Water
14 Resources and Wastewater Treatment Trust Fund" established
15 pursuant to subsection b. of section 19 of the "Dam, Lake, Stream,
16 Flood Control, Water Resources, and Wastewater Treatment Project
17 Bond Act of 2003" (P.L.2003, c.162) pursuant to P.L.2004, c.110,
18 the trust is authorized to transfer such amounts as needed to the
19 Clean Water State Revolving Fund for the purpose of providing the
20 State match as required for the award of the capitalization grants
21 made available to the State for clean water projects pursuant to the
22 Federal Clean Water Act.

23 (6) Of the sums appropriated to the trust from repayments of
24 loans deposited in any account, including the "Clean Water State
25 Revolving Fund," "Wastewater Treatment Fund," the "1992
26 Wastewater Treatment Fund," the "Water Supply Fund," the
27 "Stormwater Management and Combined Sewer Overflow
28 Abatement Fund" or the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund, as
29 appropriate, pursuant to sections 11 and 12 of P.L.1995, c.219,
30 sections 11 and 12 of P.L.1996, c.85, sections 11 and 12 of
31 P.L.1997, c.221, sections 12 and 13 of P.L.1998, c.84, section 11 of
32 P.L.1999, c.174, section 11 of P.L.2000, c.92, section 11 of
33 P.L.2001, c.222, section 11 of P.L.2002, c.70, section 11 of
34 P.L.2003, c.158, section 11 of P.L.2004, c.109, section 11 of
35 P.L.2005, c.196, section 11 of P.L.2006, c.68, section 10 of
36 P.L.2007, c.140, section 10 of P.L.2008, c.67, section 10 of
37 P.L.2009, c.101, section 10 of P.L.2010, c.62, section 10 of

45 respective fund of origin the uncommitted balance of all such
46 moneys no longer utilized by the trust for such purposes.

47 d. For the purposes of **[this act]** P.L.2018, c.84, as amended by
48 P.L. , c. (pending before the Legislature as this bill):

- 1 (1) "capitalized interest" means the amount equal to interest
2 paid on trust bonds which is funded with trust bond proceeds and
3 the earnings thereon;
- 4 (2) "debt service reserve fund expenses" means the debt service
5 reserve fund costs associated with reserve capacity expenses, water
6 supply projects for which the project sponsors are public water
7 utilities as provided in section 9 of P.L.1985, c.334 (C.58:11B-9),
8 other drinking water projects not eligible for, or interested in, State
9 or federal debt service reserve funds pursuant to the "Water Supply
10 Bond Act of 1981," P.L.1981, c.261, as amended and supplemented
11 by P.L.1997, c.223, and any clean water projects not eligible for, or
12 interested in, State or federal debt service reserve funds from the
13 Clean Water State Revolving Fund;
- 14 (3) "issuance expenses" means and includes, but need not be
15 limited to, the costs of financial document printing, bond insurance
16 premiums or other credit enhancement, underwriters' discount,
17 verification of financial calculations, the services of bond rating
18 agencies and trustees, the employment of accountants, attorneys,
19 financial advisors, loan servicing agents, registrars, and paying
20 agents, and any other costs related to the issuance of trust bonds;
- 21 (4) "loan origination fee" means the fee charged by the
22 Department of Environmental Protection and financed under the
23 trust loan to pay a portion of the costs incurred by the department in
24 the implementation of the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure
25 Financing Program; and
- 26 (5) "reserve capacity expenses" means those project costs for
27 reserve capacity not eligible for loans under rules and regulations
28 governing zero interest loans adopted by the Commissioner of
29 Environmental Protection pursuant to section 4 of P.L.1985,
30 c.329 but which are eligible for loans from the trust in accordance
31 with the rules and regulations adopted by the trust pursuant to
32 section 27 of P.L.1985, c.334 (C.58:11B-27).
- 33 e. The trust is authorized to increase the loan amount in the
34 future to compensate for a refunding of the issue, provided adequate
35 savings are achieved, for the loans issued pursuant to P.L.1995,
36 c.218, P.L.1996, c.87, P.L.1997, c.222, P.L.1998, c.85, P.L.1999,
37 c.173, P.L.2000, c.93, P.L.2001, c.224, P.L.2002, c.71, P.L.2003,
38 c.159, P.L.2004, c.110, P.L.2005, c.197, P.L.2006, c.67, P.L.2007,
39 c.140, P.L.2008, c.67, P.L.2009, c.101, P.L.2010, c.62, P.L.2011,
40 c.95, P.L.2012, c.38, P.L.2013, c.94, P.L.2014, c.26, P.L.2015,
41 c.107, P.L.2016, c.31 as amended by P.L.2017, c.13, P.L.2017,
42 c.142 as amended by P.L.2017, c.327, and P.L.2018, c.84, as

 13 amounts certified by the chairman of the trust in State fiscal years
 14 2016 and 2017 and for increased allowable costs as defined and
 15 determined in accordance with the rules and regulations adopted by
 16 the trust pursuant to section 27 of P.L.1985, c.334 (C.58:11B-27).

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STATEMENT

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37 This bill would authorize the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank
38 (NJIB) to expend additional sums to make loans for environmental
39 infrastructure projects for Fiscal Year 2019.

40 In August 2018, P.L.2018, c.84 was enacted into law, which
41 authorized the NJEIT to expend up to \$810.6 million, and any
42 unexpended balances from previous authorizations, to provide low-
43 interest and market-rate loans to project sponsors (primarily local
44 governments, public authorities, or public water utilities) for a
45 portion of the total costs of 119 eligible environmental
46 infrastructure projects for Fiscal Year 2019. This included 70
47 projects from the “Storm Sandy and State Fiscal Year 2019 Clean
48 Water Project Eligibility List” and 44 projects from the “Storm

1 Sandy and State Fiscal Year 2019 Drinking Water Project
2 Eligibility List.” The NJEIT was also authorized under P.L.2018,
3 c.84 to provide supplemental loans to five clean water projects that
4 received loans in the past and which require supplemental loans in
5 order to meet actual costs.

6 This bill would amend the lists of environmental infrastructure
7 projects for which the NJIB is authorized to make loans in
8 P.L.2018, c.84 to include new projects and remove certain projects.
9 Thus, under the bill, the NJIB would be authorized to expend up to
10 \$822.9 million, and any unexpended balances from previous
11 authorizations, to provide loans to project sponsors for a total of
12 134 eligible environmental infrastructure projects for Fiscal Year
13 2019. This would include 84 projects on the "Storm Sandy and
14 State Fiscal Year 2019 Clean Water Project Eligibility List" and 47
15 projects on the "Storm Sandy and State Fiscal Year 2019 Drinking
16 Water Project Eligibility List.” The NJIB would also be authorized
17 to make supplemental loans to three clean water environmental
18 infrastructure projects.

19 In addition, certain projects have been removed from the list of
20 projects for which the NJIB is authorized to make loans either
21 because they have already received long-term funding or because
22 the projects will not be ready to receive funding before the end of
23 Fiscal Year 2019 under NJIB program requirements.
