## P.L. 2019, Joint Resolution No. 3, *approved March 28, 2019* Senate Joint Resolution No. 120 (*First Reprint*)

A JOINT RESOLUTION designating March 22 to March 28 of each 1 2 year as "Doula Appreciation Week" in New Jersey. 3 4 WHEREAS, Doulas are trained professionals who provide continuous 5 physical, emotional, and informational support to mothers before, during, and shortly after childbirth; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Thousands of doulas are currently practicing in more 8 than 50 countries worldwide, including in all 50 U.S. states; and 9 WHEREAS, Leading professional societies such as the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology, the Society for Maternal-10 11 Fetal Medicine, and agencies <sup>1</sup>[like] including<sup>1</sup> the <sup>1</sup>federal<sup>1</sup> Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the <sup>1</sup>federal<sup>1</sup> Health 12 Resources and Services Administration, and the <sup>1</sup>federal<sup>1</sup> 13 14 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services have recognized the 15 well-established benefits of doula services; and WHEREAS, Research has demonstrated that support from a doula is 16 associated with lower <sup>1</sup>[caesarian] <u>cesarean</u><sup>1</sup> section rates, fewer 17 obstetric interventions, fewer complications during and after 18 19 childbirth, decreased use of pain medication, shorter labor hours, 20 and higher scores on the APGAR test, which indicates how well the baby is doing outside the womb; and 21 22 WHEREAS, Since 2011, World Doula Week has taken place 23 annually from March 22 to March 28 to empower doulas all over 24 the world to improve the physiological, social, emotional, and psychological health of women, newborns, and families in birth 25 and in the postpartum period; and 26 27 WHEREAS, It is altogether fitting and proper, and within the public 28 interest, to designate March 22 to March 28 of each year as "Doula Appreciation Week" in New Jersey and to encourage the 29 citizens of this State to join the observance of this week and 30 <sup>1</sup>express<sup>1</sup> appreciation for the doulas who provide support to 31 mothers in this State: now. therefore. 32 33 34 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the 35 State of New Jersey: 36 37 1. March 22 to March 28 of each year shall be designated "Doula Appreciation Week" in New Jersey. 38
