4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. The Commissioner of Education, in consultation with the
8 Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development, shall develop
9 guidelines for use by high school counselors to coordinate services
10 with representatives of the New Jersey State Building and
11 Construction Trades Council for purposes of encouraging student
12 participation in apprenticeships and raising awareness of
13 apprenticeship opportunities. The Commissioner of Education shall
14 make the guidelines available on the Department of Education's
15 website and shall update the information annually.

17 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

22 The bill requires the Commissioner of Education, in consultation
23 with the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development, to
24 develop guidelines for use by high school counselors to coordinate
25 services with representatives of the New Jersey State Building and
26 Construction Trades Council for purposes of encouraging student
27 participation in apprenticeships and raising awareness of
28 apprenticeship opportunities. The commissioner will post the
29 guidelines on the Department of Education's website and will
30 update the information annually.
