4	BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5	of New Jersey:

7	1. On or before March 30th of each year, the Attorney General
8	shall conduct a review of all persons who were released from
9	incarceration or involuntary commitment in the previous calendar
10	year and who are required to register pursuant to section 2 of
11	P.L.1994, c.133 (C.2C:7-2). The review shall determine whether
12	such persons registered pursuant to the provisions of section 2 of
13	P.L.1994, c.133 (C.2C:7-2) and were assigned a tier designation
14	pursuant to section 3 of P.L.1994, c.128 (C.2C:7-8).

16	2. This act shall take effect immediately.

19	STATEMENT
20	
21	This bill requires the Attorney General, on or before March 30th
22	of each year, to conduct a review of all persons who were released
23	from incarceration or involuntary commitment in the previous
24	calendar year and who are required to register as a sex offender.
25	The review is to determine whether such persons actually did
26	register and whether they were tiered by the county prosecutors.
