Section 7 of P.L.1997, c.38 (C.44:10-61) is repealed. 8 9 2. The Commissioner of Human Services shall apply for such State plan amendments as may be necessary to implement the 10 provisions of this act and to secure federal financial participation 11 for State expenditures under the federal Temporary Assistance to 12 13 Needy Families program. 14 15 3. The Commissioner of Human Services, in accordance with the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 16 et seq.), shall adopt such rules and regulations as the commissioner 17 deems necessary to carry out the provisions of this act. 18 19 20 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
