1 Green Building Council. Under that law, only new buildings
2 having at least 15,000 square feet in total floor area that is to be
3 constructed for the sole use of a State government entity must be
4 designed and managed to meet standards for a high performance
5 green building.

6 The Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design Green
7 Building Rating System is an effort to rate how the building
8 industry and the public consider sustainability in real estate. The
9 most recent update is known as v4, which is the new standard for
10 high-performance green buildings worldwide.
