Each board of education which operates an educational program for public school students in grades 9 through 12 shall provide information on the provisions of the "New Jersey Safe Haven Infant Protection Act," P.L.2000, c.58 (C.30:4C-15.5 et seq.). The instruction shall take place as part of the district's implementation of the New Jersey Student Learning Standards in Comprehensive Health and Physical Education.
