Requires certain school district transportation supervisors to complete educational program.

1 AN ACT concerning school district transportation supervisors and
 2 supplementing chapter 39 of Title 18A of the New Jersey
 3 Statutes.

 5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
 6 *of New Jersey:*

 8 1. ²a.² Beginning in the 2021-2022 school year, a school
 9 district transportation supervisor who is newly hired or who has less
 10 than 11 years of experience as a school district transportation
 11 supervisor shall be required, as a condition of employment, to
 12 provide evidence to the board of education of satisfactory
 13 completion of the School Transportation Supervisors ¹Certification¹
 14 Program offered by the Center for Government Services at
 15 Rutgers ¹, the State¹ University ¹of New Jersey or any other
 16 certification program designated by the Commissioner of
 17 Education¹. ²The certification program shall include courses
 18 focused on the statutes and regulations that govern school
 19 transportation operations.² The transportation supervisor ²**[shall**
 20 **bear the full]** and the school district shall determine who bears² the
 21 cost of the program.

22 ²b. (1) A school district transportation supervisor who is
 23 employed on the effective date of this act, who has less than 11
 24 years of experience as a school district transportation supervisor
 25 and has not completed the School Transportation Supervisors
 26 Certification Program or other designated certification program,
 27 shall complete the certification program within four years of the
 28 effective date of this act.

29 (2) A school district transportation supervisor who is employed
 30 after the effective date of this act, who has less than 11 years of
 31 experience as a school district transportation supervisor and has not
 32 completed the School Transportation Supervisors Certification
 33 Program or other designated certification program, shall complete
 34 the certification program within four years of his date of
 35 employment.²

 37 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
