#### **SYNOPSIS**

Directs DOE to develop Veterans in the Schools Program to teach students about military experiences of local veterans.

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AN ACT concerning veteran education in public schools and
supplementing chapter 35 of Title 18A of the New Jersey
statutes.

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**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

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8 The Commissioner of Education shall develop 1. a. 9 guidelines for school districts for the implementation of a Veterans 10 in the Schools Program. The purpose of the program shall be to 11 educate students on the service and experiences of veterans and to 12 recognize the contributions veterans have made to our nation. 13 Under the program, participating school districts shall invite local 14 veterans to schools to speak to students about their military service 15 and experiences. The program shall include a student participation 16 component, such as pertinent reading or writing assignments or 17 opportunities for students to share their own families' stories of 18 military service. In developing guidelines for the program, the 19 commissioner shall consult with the Department of Military and 20 Veterans' Affairs, veterans who reside in the State, and school 21 personnel.

b. A school district, in accordance with the guidelines 22 23 developed by the commissioner, may establish a Veterans in the 24 Schools Program for students in grades seven through 12. The 25 program may be conducted in a school assembly format or in 26 individual classrooms. A school district that establishes a Veterans 27 in the Schools Program may work collaboratively with the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs, the county veterans 28 29 service office, and veterans organizations to implement the 30 program.

2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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### STATEMENT

37 This bill directs the Commissioner of Education to develop guidelines for school districts for the implementation of a Veterans 38 39 in the Schools Program. The program's purpose is to educate 40 students on the service and experiences of veterans and to recognize 41 the contributions veterans have made to our nation. Under the 42 program, participating school districts will invite local veterans to 43 schools to speak to students about their military service and 44 experiences. The program also will include a student participation 45 component, such as pertinent reading or writing assignments or opportunities for students to share their own families' stories of 46 47 military service.

## S2789 VAN DREW, OROHO

Under the bill, school districts may establish a Veterans in the 1 2 Schools Program for students in grades seven through 12. The program will follow the guidelines developed by the commissioner 3 4 and may be implemented in collaboration with the Department of 5 Military and Veterans' Affairs, the local county veterans service 6 office, and veterans organizations.

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
