1 AN ACT concerning the training of school bus drivers and school 2 bus aides and supplementing chapter 39 of Title 18A of the New 3 Jersey Statutes. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 1. a. As used in this section, "employer" means a board of 9 education or a contractor that provides pupil transportation services under contract with a board of education. 10 11 b. An employer shall ensure that all school bus drivers and school 12 bus aides are properly trained for the functions of their positions. c. An employer shall administer a safety education program for 13 all permanent and substitute school bus drivers and school bus aides 14 15 that it employs. At a minimum, the training shall include: (1) student management and discipline; 16 17 (2) school bus accident and emergency procedures; 18 (3) conducting school bus emergency exit drills; 19 (4) loading and unloading procedures; 20 (5) school bus stop loading zone safety; 21 (6) inspecting the school vehicle for students left on board at the 22 end of a route; and 23 (7) the use of a student's education records, including the 24 employee's responsibility to ensure the privacy of the student and the 25 student's records, if applicable. 26 d. In addition to the training requirements in subsection c. of this 27 section, an employer shall administer to school bus drivers a safety education program that includes defensive driving techniques and 28 29 railroad crossing procedures. 30 e. The employer shall administer the safety education program set forth in subsections c. and d. of this section twice ¹[each school] per 31 calendar¹ year ¹[, once at the beginning of the school year and once 32 during the second semester]¹. 33 34 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 35
