1 AN ACT concerning the comprehensive policy for managing black
2 bear and amending P.L.1948, c.448.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Section 30 of P.L.1948, c.448 (C.13:1B-28) is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 30. In addition to its powers and duties otherwise hereinafter
10 provided, the Fish and Game Council shall, subject to the approval
11 of the commissioner, formulate comprehensive policies for the
12 protection and propagation of fish, birds, and game animals and for
13 the propagation and distribution of food fish and for the keeping up
14 of the supply thereof in the waters of the State.

15 The council shall update the comprehensive policy for the
16 management of black bear on an annual basis.

17 The council shall also:

18 a. Consult with and advise the commissioner and director of
19 the Division of Fish and **[Game]** Wildlife with respect to the work
20 of such division.

21 b. Study the activities of the Division of Fish and **[Game]**
22 Wildlife and hold hearings with respect thereto as it may deem
23 necessary or desirable.

24 c. Report to the Governor and the Legislature annually, and at
25 such other times as it may deem in the public interest, with respect
26 to its findings and conclusions.

29 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

34 This bill would require the Fish and Game Council to update the
35 comprehensive policy for the management of black bear on an
36 annual basis. The updated policy would be subject to the approval
37 of the Commissioner of Environmental Protection.
