CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

As reported by the Senate Transportation Committee on March 18, 2019, with amendments.



1 AN ACT designating the Morris Plains rail station as the "Frank J. 2 Druetzler Station - Morris Plains, New Jersey." 3 WHEREAS, The Honorable Frank J. Druetzler has lived his entire life 4 5 in Morris County, first residing in ¹the Township of ¹ Hanover before relocating to ¹the Borough of ¹ Morris Plains ¹(Morris 6 Plains)¹ in 1960; and 7 8 WHEREAS, Frank J. Druetzler began his distinguished career in public 9 service as a member of the Morris Plains Borough Council; and 10 WHEREAS, In 1986, Frank J. Druetzler was elected Mayor of Morris Plains where, over a 32 year career, he had many significant 11 12 achievements; and WHEREAS, Mayor Druetzler was responsible for the creation of 13 14 several events that have made Morris Plains a place that children 15 and their families have loved to call "home," including the annual Memorial Day parade, "Family Day," the town bonfire, and "Uncle 16 Frank's Fishing Contest"; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Mayor Druetzler truly embodies all that makes Morris 19 Plains "The Community of Caring"; and 20 WHEREAS, Mayor Druetzler led efforts to expand the Morris Plains park system and convert the Community Park School into a heavily 21 22 used and deeply appreciated community center; and 23 WHEREAS, Mayor Druetzler led efforts to create the Morris Plains September 11, 2001, memorial, which features ¹[3] three ¹ steel 24 beams from the North Tower of the World Trade Center; and 25 26 WHEREAS, In addition to serving as Mayor of Morris Plains, Frank J. 27 Druetzler also served as a member of the Board of Chosen Freeholders in Morris County from 1992 to 2006; and 28 29 WHEREAS, As a Freeholder, Frank J. Druetzler was part of the board 30 that voted for the construction of a \$32 million, state-of-the-art corrections facility in ¹[Morris Township] the Township of 31 Morris¹; and 32 WHEREAS, As a Freeholder, Frank J. Druetzler is also credited with 33 34 leading efforts to expand and renovate the county juvenile detention 35 center and human services building; and WHEREAS, As a Freeholder, Frank J. Druetzler led the preservation of 36 37 300 acres of land at Greystone, which has now become the 38 preeminent park to enjoy in Morris County; and 39 WHEREAS, Mayor Druetzler's extensive record of inspired and 40 effective civic leadership has earned for him the deepest respect and 41 regard of his fellow citizens, and his steadfast dedication has 42 exemplified the true meaning of selfless public service; and 43 WHEREAS, The strength and success of the State of New Jersey, the

society depend, in great measure, upon dynamic and selfless individuals, as exemplified by Mayor Frank J. Druetzler; and

WHEREAS, With an unwavering devotion to the people of Morris Plains and Morris County, it is fitting and proper for the Legislature of the State of New Jersey to honor Frank J. Druetzler by designating the Morris Plains rail station as the "Frank J. Druetzler Station – Morris Plains, New Jersey"; now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

¹[1.The Executive Director of the New Jersey Transit Corporation shall designate the Morris Plains rail station as the "Frank J. Druetzler Station – Morris Plains, New Jersey" in commemoration of his outstanding service and erect appropriate signs bearing this designation and dedication.]¹

¹1. The rail station operated by the New Jersey Transit Corporation in the Borough of Morris Plains and known as the "Morris Plains Station" is designated as the "Frank J. Druetzler Station – Morris Plains, New Jersey" and shall henceforth ceremoniously be known by that name. ¹

2. State or other public funds shall not be used for producing, purchasing, or erecting signs bearing the designation established pursuant to section 1 of this act. The Executive Director of the New Jersey Transit Corporation is authorized to receive gifts, grants, or other financial assistance from private sources for the purpose of funding or reimbursing the New Jersey Transit Corporation for the costs associated with producing, purchasing, erecting, and maintaining signs bearing the designation established pursuant to section 1 of this act and entering into agreements related thereto, with private sources, including but not limited to non-governmental non-profit, educational, or charitable entities or institutions. Work shall not proceed and funding shall not be accepted by the New Jersey Transit Corporation until an agreement has been reached with a responsible party for paying the costs associated with producing, purchasing, erecting, and maintaining the signs.

3. This act shall take effect immediately.
