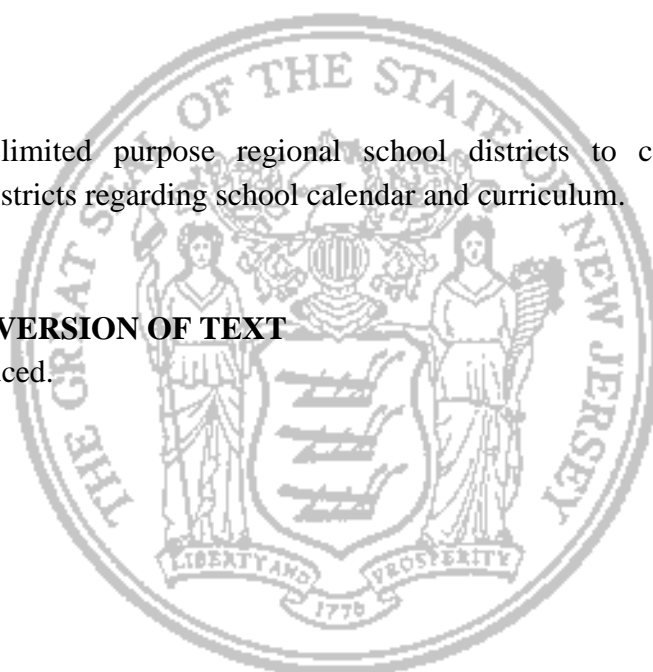

SYNOPSIS

Requires limited purpose regional school districts to coordinate with constituent districts regarding school calendar and curriculum.

1 AN ACT concerning limited purpose regional school districts and
2 supplementing chapter 13 of Title 18A of the New Jersey
3 Statutes.

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5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

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8 1. The board of education of a limited purpose regional school
9 district shall meet and work with the constituent school districts of
10 the regional district, on at least an annual basis, to:

11 a. coordinate the school calendars of the limited purpose
12 regional school district and the constituent school districts in order
13 to ensure consistency across the districts; and

14 b. review and analyze the curriculum of each constituent school
15 district to facilitate consistency in the educational program and in
16 the articulation and alignment of the curriculum of students who
17 will attend the constituent school districts and the limited purpose
18 regional school district.

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20 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATEMENT

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25 This bill would require the board of education of a limited
26 purpose regional school district to meet and work with the
27 constituent school districts of the regional district, on at least an
28 annual basis, to: (1) coordinate the school calendars of the limited
29 purpose regional district and the constituent districts in order to
30 ensure consistency across the districts; and (2) review and analyze
31 the curriculum of each constituent school district in order to
32 facilitate consistency in the educational program and in the
33 articulation and alignment of the curriculum of students who will
34 attend the constituent districts and the limited purpose regional
35 district.
