1	AN ACT concerning the purchase of lottery tickets through
2	decoupled debit as an electronic fund payment method and
3	supplementing P.L.1970, c.13 (C.5:9-1 et seq.).

5	BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6	of New Jersey:

8	1. a. For the purposes of this act, P.L., c. (C.) (pending
9	before the Legislature as this bill), "decoupled debit" means an
10	electronic fund transfer by an entity that does not hold the enrolled
11	user's bank account and uses the automated clearing house network
12	to debit the user's checking account for the settlement of
13	transactions.
14	b. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, rule, or
15	regulation to the contrary, a licensed lottery sales agent operating in
16	this State may accept decoupled debit as a form of payment from
17	patrons for the purchase of lottery tickets.
18	c. The State Lottery Commission shall promulgate rules and
19	regulations, pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act,"
20	P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), as may be needed to
21	effectuate the provisions of this act.

23	2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the third month
24	following enactment, except that the State Lottery Commission may
25	take any anticipatory administrative action in advance as shall be
26	necessary for the implementation of this act.

29	STATEMENT
30	
31	The bill permits lottery sales agents to accept decoupled debit as
32	a form of payment from patrons for the purchase of lottery tickets.

Under the bill, "decoupled debit" means an electronic fund transfer by an entity that does not hold the enrolled user's bank account and uses the automated clearing house network to debit the user's checking account for the settlement of transactions.
