SYNOPSIS

Authorizes NJ Infrastructure Bank to expend additional sums to make loans for environmental infrastructure projects for FY2020.

1 AN ACT authorizing the expenditure of additional funds by the New
 2 Jersey Infrastructure Bank for the purpose of making loans to
 3 eligible project sponsors to finance a portion of the cost of
 4 construction of environmental infrastructure projects, and
 5 amending P.L.2019, c.192.

 7 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
 8 of New Jersey:

9
 10 1. Section 1 of P.L.2019, c.192 is amended to read as follows:

11 1. a. The New Jersey Infrastructure Bank, established pursuant to
 12 P.L.1985, c.334 (C.58:11B-1 et seq.), is authorized to expend the
 13 aggregate sum of up to **[\$655.04 million]** \$1.7 billion and any
 14 uncommitted balance of the aggregate expenditures authorized
 15 pursuant to section 1 of P.L.2000, c.93, section 1 of P.L.2001, c.224,
 16 section 1 of P.L.2002, c.71, section 1 of P.L.2003, c.159, section 1 of
 17 P.L.2004, c.110, section 1 of P.L.2005, c.197, section 1 of P.L.2006,
 18 c.67, section 1 of P.L.2007, c.140, section 1 of P.L.2008, c.67, section
 19 1 of P.L.2009, c.101, section 1 of P.L.2010, c.62, section 1 of
 20 P.L.2011, c.95, section 1 of P.L.2012, c.38, section 1 of P.L.2013,
 21 c.94, section 1 of P.L.2014, c.26, section 1 of P.L.2015, c.107, section
 22 1 of P.L.2016, c.31 as amended by P.L.2017, c.13, section 1 of
 23 P.L.2017, c.142 as amended by P.L.2017, c.327, and P.L.2018, c.84 as
 24 amended by P.L.2019, c.30, for the purpose of making loans, to the
 25 extent sufficient funds are available, to or on behalf of local
 26 government units or public water utilities (hereinafter referred to as
 27 "project sponsors") to finance all or a portion of the cost of
 28 construction of environmental infrastructure projects listed in sections
 29 2 and 4 of **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c.
 30 (pending before the Legislature as this bill).

31 b. The trust is authorized to increase the aggregate sums specified
 32 in subsection a. of this section by:

33 (1) the amounts of capitalized interest , administrative expenses
 34 associated with any federal funding programs, if applicable, and the
 35 bond issuance expenses as provided in subsection b. of section 7 of
 36 **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c. (pending
 37 before the Legislature as this bill);

38 (2) the amounts of reserve capacity expenses and debt service
 39 reserve fund requirements as provided in subsection c. of section 7 of
 40 **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c. (pending
 41 before the Legislature as this bill);

42 (3) the interest earned on amounts deposited for project costs
 43 pending their distribution to project sponsors as provided in subsection
 44 d. of section 7 of **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. ,
 45 c. (pending before the Legislature as this bill);

1 (4) the amounts of the loan origination fee as provided in
2 subsection e. of section 7 of **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended
3 by P.L. , c. (pending before the Legislature as this bill); and

4 (5) the amount appropriated to the Department of Environmental
5 Protection for the purpose of making zero interest and principal
6 forgiveness loans pursuant to section 3 of P.L.2019, c.193 , as
7 amended by P.L. , c. (pending before the Legislature as Senate Bill
8 No. 4201 and Assembly Bill No. of 2019), in connection with the
9 project costs of a particular project sponsor, to the extent the priority
10 ranking or an insufficiency of funding prevent the department from
11 meeting program demand as provided in subsection f. of section 7 of
12 **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c. (pending
13 before the Legislature as this bill).

14 c. (1) Of the sums made available to the trust from the “Water
15 Supply Trust Fund” established pursuant to subsection a. of section 15
16 of the "Water Supply Bond Act of 1981" (P.L.1981, c.261) pursuant to
17 P.L.1997, c.223, the trust is authorized to transfer such amounts to the
18 Department of Environmental Protection as needed for drinking water
19 project loans pursuant to the “Safe Drinking Water Act Amendments
20 of 1996,” Pub.L.104-182, and any amendatory and supplementary acts
21 thereto (hereinafter referred to as the "Federal Safe Drinking Water
22 Act"), under terms and conditions established by the Commissioner of
23 Environmental Protection and trust, and approved by the State
24 Treasurer, which loans shall be jointly administered by the trust and
25 department.

26 (2) Of the sums appropriated to the trust from the "Wastewater
27 Treatment Trust Fund" established pursuant to section 15 of the
28 "Wastewater Treatment Bond Act of 1985," (P.L.1985, c.329)
29 pursuant to P.L.1987, c.198, the trust is authorized to transfer such
30 amounts as needed to the Clean Water State Revolving Fund
31 established pursuant to section 1 of P.L.2009, c.77 for the purposes of
32 issuing loans or providing the State match as required for the award of
33 the capitalization grants made available to the State for clean water
34 projects pursuant to the "Water Quality Act of 1987" (33 U.S.C.
35 s.1251 et seq.), and any amendatory and supplementary acts thereto
36 (hereinafter referred to as the "Federal Clean Water Act").

37 (3) Of the sums appropriated to the trust from the "1992
38 Wastewater Treatment Trust Fund" established pursuant to section 27
39 of the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and Historic Preservation
40 Bond Act of 1992" (P.L.1992, c.88) pursuant to P.L.1996, c.86, the
41 trust is authorized to transfer such amounts as needed to the Clean
42 Water State Revolving Fund for the purpose of providing the State
43 match as required for the award of the capitalization grants made
44 available to the State for clean water projects pursuant to the Federal
45 Clean Water Act.

46 (4) Of the sums appropriated to the trust from the "Stormwater
47 Management and Combined Sewer Overflow Abatement Fund"
48 created pursuant to section 14 of the "Stormwater Management and

1 Combined Sewer Overflow Abatement Bond Act of 1989" (P.L.1989,
2 c.181) pursuant to P.L.1998, c.87, the trust is authorized to transfer
3 such amounts as needed to the Clean Water State Revolving Fund for
4 the purpose of providing the State match as required for the award of
5 the capitalization grants made available to the State for clean water
6 projects pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act.

7 (5) Of the sums appropriated to the trust from the "2003 Water
8 Resources and Wastewater Treatment Trust Fund" established
9 pursuant to subsection b. of section 19 of the "Dam, Lake, Stream,
10 Flood Control, Water Resources, and Wastewater Treatment Project
11 Bond Act of 2003" (P.L.2003, c.162) pursuant to P.L.2004, c.110, the
12 trust is authorized to transfer such amounts as needed to the Clean
13 Water State Revolving Fund for the purpose of providing the State
14 match as required for the award of the capitalization grants made
15 available to the State for clean water projects pursuant to the Federal
16 Clean Water Act.

17 (6) Of the sums appropriated to the trust from repayments of loans
18 deposited in any account, including the "Clean Water State Revolving
19 Fund," "Wastewater Treatment Fund," the "1992 Wastewater
20 Treatment Fund," the "Water Supply Fund," the "Stormwater
21 Management and Combined Sewer Overflow Abatement Fund" or the
22 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund, as appropriate, pursuant to
23 sections 11 and 12 of P.L.1995, c.219, sections 11 and 12 of P.L.1996,
24 c.85, sections 11 and 12 of P.L.1997, c.221, sections 12 and 13 of
25 P.L.1998, c.84, section 11 of P.L.1999, c.174, section 11 of P.L.2000,
26 c.92, section 11 of P.L.2001, c.222, section 11 of P.L.2002, c.70,
27 section 11 of P.L.2003, c.158, section 11 of P.L.2004, c.109, section
28 11 of P.L.2005, c.196, section 11 of P.L.2006, c.68, section 10 of

37 into one or more reserve funds or accounts established by the trust
38 pursuant to section 11 of P.L.1985, c.334 (C.58:11B-11), the trust shall
39 transfer to the respective fund of origin the uncommitted balance of all
40 such moneys no longer utilized by the trust for such purposes.

41 d. For the purposes of **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended
42 by P.L. __, c. (pending before the Legislature as this bill):

43 (1) "capitalized interest" means the amount equal to interest paid
44 on trust bonds which is funded with trust bond proceeds and the
45 earnings thereon;

46 (2) "debt service reserve fund expenses" means the debt service
47 reserve fund costs associated with reserve capacity expenses, water
48 supply projects for which the project sponsors are public water utilities

1 as provided in section 9 of P.L.1985, c.334 (C.58:11B-9), other
2 drinking water projects not eligible for, or interested in, State or
3 federal debt service reserve funds pursuant to the "Water Supply Bond
4 Act of 1981," P.L.1981, c.261 as amended and supplemented by
5 P.L.1997, c.223, and any clean water projects not eligible for, or
6 interested in, State or federal debt service reserve funds from the Clean
7 Water State Revolving Fund;

8 (3) "issuance expenses" means and includes, but need not be
9 limited to, the costs of financial document printing, bond insurance
10 premiums or other credit enhancement, underwriters' discount,
11 verification of financial calculations, the services of bond rating
12 agencies and trustees, the employment of accountants, attorneys,
13 financial advisors, loan servicing agents, registrars, and paying agents,
14 and any other costs related to the issuance of trust bonds;

15 (4) "loan origination fee" means the fee charged by the
16 Department of Environmental Protection and financed under the trust
17 loan to pay a portion of the costs incurred by the department in the
18 implementation of the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure
19 Financing Program; and

20 (5) "reserve capacity expenses" means those project costs for
21 reserve capacity not eligible for loans under rules and regulations
22 governing zero interest loans adopted by the Commissioner of
23 Environmental Protection pursuant to section 4 of P.L.1985, c.329 but
24 which are eligible for loans from the trust in accordance with the rules
25 and regulations adopted by the trust pursuant to section 27 of
26 P.L.1985, c.334 (C.58:11B-27).

27 e. The trust is authorized to increase the loan amount in the future
28 to compensate for a refunding of the issue, provided adequate savings
29 are achieved, for the loans issued pursuant to P.L.1995, c.218,
30 P.L.1996, c.87, P.L.1997, c.222, P.L.1998, c.85, P.L.1999, c.173,
31 P.L.2000, c.93, P.L.2001, c.224, P.L.2002, c.71, P.L.2003, c.159,
32 P.L.2004, c.110, P.L.2005, c.197, P.L.2006, c.67, P.L.2007, c.140,
33 P.L.2008, c.67, P.L.2009, c.101, P.L.2010, c.62, P.L.2011, c.95,
34 P.L.2012, c.38, P.L.2013, c.94, P.L.2014, c.26, P.L.2015, c.107,
35 P.L.2016, c.31 as amended by P.L.2017, c.13, P.L.2017, c.142 as
36 amended by P.L.2017, c.327, P.L.2018, c.84 as amended by P.L.2019,
37 c.30, and P.L.2019, c.192 , as amended by P.L. , c. (pending
38 before the Legislature as this bill).

2 (2) The loan authorized in this subsection shall be made for the

3 difference between the allowable loan amount required by the

4 project based upon final building costs pursuant to subsection a. of

5 section 7 of **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c.

6 (pending before the Legislature as this bill) and the loan amount

7 certified by the chairman of the trust in State fiscal year 2017 and

8 for increased allowable costs as defined and determined in

9 accordance with the rules and regulations adopted by the trust

10 pursuant to section 27 of P.L.1985, c.334 (C.58:11B-27). The loan

11 authorized in this subsection shall be made to or on behalf of the

12 project sponsor listed, up to the individual amount indicated and in

13 the priority stated, to the extent sufficient funds are available,

14 except as a project fails to meet the requirements of section 6 of

15 **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c. (pending

16 before the Legislature as this bill).

17 (3) The loan authorized in this subsection shall have priority

18 over the environmental infrastructure projects listed in subsection a.

19 of section 4 of **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c.

20 (pending before the Legislature as this bill).

21 b. The trust is authorized to adjust the allowable trust loan

22 amount for the project authorized in this section to between 25

23 percent and 75 percent of the total allowable loan amount and such

24 excess amounts to the extent the priority ranking or an insufficiency

25 of funding prevent the Department of Environmental Protection

26 from meeting program demand as provided in subsection f. of

27 section 7 of **[this act]** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c.

28 (pending before the Legislature as this bill).

2 section 7 of **【this act】** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c.
3 (pending before the Legislature as this bill), or if a project fails to
4 meet the requirements of section 6 of **【this act】** P.L.2019, c.192, as

15 be reduced by the trust pursuant to subsection a. of section 7 of

17 before the Legislature as this bill), or if a project fails to meet the
18 requirements of section 6 of **【this act】** P.L.2019, c.192, as amended

29 be reduced by the trust pursuant to subsection a. of section 7 of
30 P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c. (pending before the
31 Legislature as this bill), or if a project fails to meet the requirements
32 of section 6 of P.L.2019, c.192, as amended by P.L. , c. (pending
33 before the Legislature as this bill).
