There is appropriated to the Department of Environmental Protection the sum of \$8,872,682 from the dedicated corporation business tax revenues pursuant to Article VIII, Section II, paragraph 6 of the State Constitution in the "Preserve New Jersey Green Acres Fund," established pursuant to section 6 of the "Preserve New Jersey Act," P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-48), and the unexpended balances in the Diesel Risk Mitigation Fund - Constitutional Dedication account and the Diesel Risk Mitigation Fund Administrative Costs - Constitutional Dedication account made available for this purpose pursuant to the provisions of P.L.2019, c.150, for the purpose of providing grants to assist qualifying tax exempt nonprofit organizations to acquire lands for recreation and conservation purposes pursuant to subsection b. of this section, to develop lands for recreation and conservation purposes pursuant to subsection c. of this section, and to undertake stewardship activities pursuant to subsection d. of this section:

e. Any transfer of any funds, or change in project sponsor, site, or type, listed in subsection b., c., or d. of this section shall require the approval of the Joint Budget Oversight Committee or its successor.

f. To the extent that moneys remain available after the projects listed in subsection b., c., or d. of this section are offered funding pursuant thereto, any project of a qualifying tax exempt nonprofit organization that previously received funding appropriated or reappropriated from any Green Acres bond act, any annual appropriations act, or the Garden State Green Acres Preservation Trust Fund for recreation and conservation purposes shall be eligible to receive additional funding, as determined by the Department of Environmental Protection, subject to the approval of the Joint Budget Oversight Committee or its successor.

g. The bill appropriates \$8,872,682 to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to provide grants to various nonprofit entities to acquire or develop lands for recreation and conservation purposes.

The funding in this bill is provided from constitutionally dedicated corporation business tax (CBT) revenues pursuant to Article VIII, Section II, paragraph 6 of the State Constitution, approved by the voters of the State in November 2014, including the unexpended balances in the Diesel Risk Mitigation Fund -Constitutional Dedication and Diesel Risk Mitigation Fund Administrative Costs - Constitutional Dedication accounts made available for these purposes pursuant to P.L.2019, c.150 (i.e., the

48 FY2020 annual appropriations act). The "Preserve New Jersey

1 Act," P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-43 et seq.), implements the 2 constitutional dedication of CBT revenues for open space, farmland, 3 and historic preservation. The "Preserve New Jersey Green Acres 4 Fund" was established by section 6 of the "Preserve New Jersey 5 Act." The act provides that a certain amount of the portion of 6 dedicated CBT revenues allocated each year for the Green Acres 7 program is to be used for: the acquisition of lands for open space, 8 including Blue Acres projects, and development projects on State 9 lands administered by the DEP's Division of Fish and Wildlife and 10 Division of Parks and Forestry; grants and loans to fund local 11 government open space acquisition and development projects; and grants to nonprofit entities to acquire or develop lands for 12 13 recreation and conservation purposes. This bill appropriates funds 14 to be used to provide grants to nonprofit entities to acquire or 15 develop lands for recreation and conservation purposes. Further, of 16 the funding allocated for acquisition and development projects by 17 nonprofit entities, a certain percentage is to be used to fund 18 stewardship activities undertaken by nonprofit entities. 19 "stewardship activity" is defined in the "Preserve New Jersey Act" 20 as an activity, which is beyond routine operations and maintenance, 21 undertaken to repair or restore lands acquired or developed for 22 recreation and conservation purposes for the purpose of enhancing 23 or protecting those lands for recreation and conservation purposes. 24

Of the amount appropriated by the bill to provide grants to various nonprofit entities: \$6,147,219 is allocated for acquisition projects; \$1,924,230 is allocated for park development projects; and \$801,233 is allocated for stewardship activity projects.

The projects listed in this bill have been approved by the DEP and the Garden State Preservation Trust.

The bill also would allow the DEP to re-distribute certain other moneys, which have been returned to the department due to project withdrawals, cancellations, or cost savings, for the purpose of providing additional funding, for recreation and conservation purposes, to previously approved and funded projects of nonprofit entities, subject to the approval of the Joint Budget Oversight Committee. This additional funding, if provided from a Green Acres bond act, may include administrative costs.
