BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

- 1. Section 1 of P.L.1968, c.227 (C.40:33-8.1) is amended to read as follows:
- 9 40:33-8.1. The county library commission of any county or the 10 board of trustees of any regional library established by 2 or more counties may, within the limits of funds appropriated or otherwise 11 12 made available to the commission or board, purchase the following 13 without advertising for bids therefor: (1) library materials including 14 periodicals, newspapers, documents, 15 photographs, reproductions, microforms, pictorial or graphic works, 16 musical scores, maps, charts, globes, sound recordings, slides, 17 films, filmstrips, video and magnetic tapes, other printed or 18 published matter, and audiovisual and other materials of a similar 19 nature; (2) necessary binding or rebinding of library materials; and 20 (3) specialized library services.
 - The county library commission or the board of trustees may dispose of the following without advertising for bids therefor: library materials including books, periodicals, newspapers, documents, pamphlets, photographs, reproductions, microforms, pictorial or graphic works, musical scores, maps, charts, globes, sound recordings, slides, films, filmstrips, video and magnetic tapes, other printed or published matter, and audiovisual and other materials of a similar nature.

- 31 2. Section 2 of P.L.1968, c.227 (C.40:54-12.1) is amended to 32 read as follows:
- 33 40:54-12.1. The board of trustees of the free public library of 34 any municipality or of a joint free public library may, within the 35 limits of funds appropriated or otherwise made available to the 36 board, purchase the following without advertising for bids therefor: 37 (1) library materials including books, periodicals, newspapers, 38 documents, pamphlets, photographs, reproductions, microforms, 39 pictorial or graphic works, musical scores, maps, charts, globes, 40 sound recordings, slides, films, filmstrips, video and magnetic tapes, other printed or published matter, and audiovisual and other 41 42 materials of a similar nature; (2) necessary binding or rebinding of 43 library materials; and (3) specialized library services.
- The board of trustees may dispose of the following without 45 advertising for bids therefor: library materials including books,
