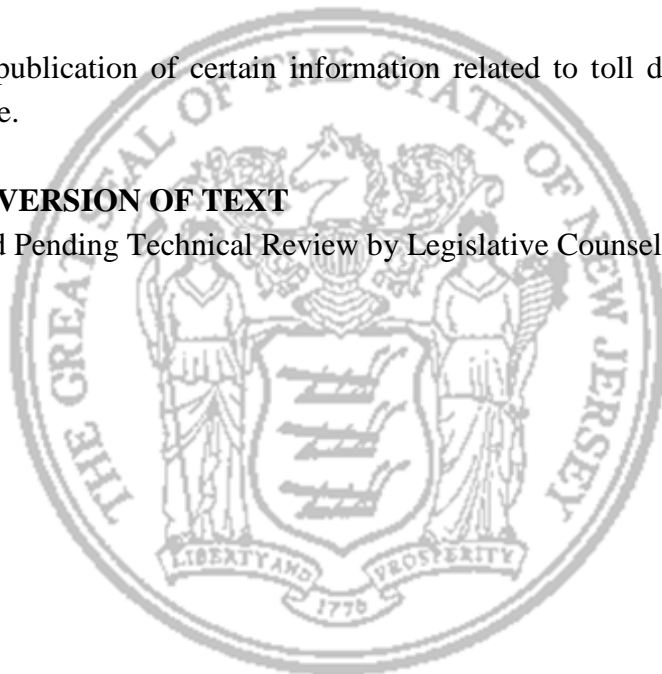

Requires publication of certain information related to toll discounts on E-ZPass website.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

1 AN ACT concerning certain information related to toll rate discounts
2 and supplementing P.L.1997, c.59 (C.27:12B-18.2 et al.).

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. The lead agency of the New Jersey E-ZPass Group shall, on
8 every publicly accessible webpage of a website in which the lead
9 agency provides information concerning the purchase of an
10 electronic vehicle identification system transponder or the initiation
11 of an account with a New Jersey electronic toll collection system,
12 subject to sections 6 through 10 of P.L.1997, c.59 (C.27:23-34.1
13 through C.27:23-34.5) or sections 11 through 15 of P.L.1997, c.59
14 (C.27:25A-21.1 through C.27:25A-21.5), publish information that
15 notifies customers and prospective customers that discounts on toll
16 rates advertised by an operator of an electronic toll collection
17 system not under the jurisdiction of the State, any agency or
18 authority of the State, or any political subdivisions thereof, may not
19 be applicable to an account with a New Jersey electronic toll
20 collection system subject to sections 6 through 10 of P.L.1997, c.59
21 (C.27:23-34.1 through C.27:23-34.5) or sections 11 through 15 of
22 P.L.1997, c.59 (C.27:25A-21.1 through C.27:25A-21.5).

23 As used in this section, “lead agency of the New Jersey E-ZPass
24 Group” or “lead agency” means an agency, authority, or political
25 subdivision of this State which has the authority to enter into,
26 manage, or negotiate contracts to provide service to accounts with a
27 New Jersey electronic toll collection system subject to sections 6
28 through 10 of P.L.1997, c.59 (C.27:23-34.1 through C.27:23-34.5)
29 or sections 11 through 15 of P.L.1997, c.59 (C.27:25A-21.1 through
30 C.27:25A-21.5).

32 2. This act shall take effect on the 30th day following

STATEMENT

38 This bill directs the lead agency of the New Jersey E-
39 ZPass Group to notify customers or prospective customers, on certain
40 webpages, that discounts on toll rates advertised by an operator of an
41 E-ZPass system that is not under the jurisdiction of the State or one of
42 its agencies, authorities, or political subdivisions may not be
43 applicable to New Jersey E-ZPass accounts.

44 The bill defines “lead agency of the New Jersey E-ZPass Group”
45 or “lead agency” as an agency, authority, or political subdivision of
46 this State which has the authority to enter into, manage, or negotiate
47 contracts to provide service to accounts with New Jersey E-ZPass.
48 Currently, the lead agency of the New Jersey E-ZPass Group is the
49 New Jersey Turnpike Authority.
