1 AN ACT concerning the “Honor and Remember Flag” and amending  
2 P.L.2012, c.66.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Section 1 of P.L.2012, c.66 (C.52:3-13) is amended to read  
8 as follows:

9 1. a. The “Honor and Remember Flag” is designated as the  
10 State's official flag for recognizing all armed service members who  
11 have died as a result of serving the United States in any war or  
12 conflict the nation has been involved in since its inception.

13 b. The flag shall be displayed during normal business hours at  
14 the State House in Trenton, the principal municipal building in each  
15 municipality, and the principal county building in each county seat.

18 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

23 This bill mandates that the “Honor and Remember Flag” be  
24 displayed during normal business hours at the State House in  
25 Trenton, the principal municipal building in each municipality, and  
26 the principal county building in each county seat.

27 The “Honor and Remember Flag” is the State’s official flag for  
28 recognizing all armed service members who have died as a result of  
29 serving the United States in any war or conflict the nation has been  
30 involved in since its inception.
