5	BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6	of New Jersey:

8	1. A public school that includes any of the grades seven
9	through 12 and that issues student identification cards shall have
10	printed on the back of the student identification cards the telephone
11	number for a suicide prevention hotline.

13	2. An institution of higher education that issues student
14	identification cards shall have printed on the back of the student
15	identification cards the telephone number for a suicide prevention
16	hotline.

18	3. Section 1 of this act shall take effect in the first full school
19	year following the date of enactment, and section 2 of this act shall
20	take effect in the first full academic year following the date of
21	enactment.

24	STATEMENT
25	
26	This bill requires a public school that includes any of the grades
27	seven through 12 and that issues student identification cards to have
28	the telephone number for a suicide prevention hotline printed on the
29	back of the student identification cards. The bill also requires an
30	institution of higher education that issues student identification
31	cards to have the telephone number for a suicide prevention hotline
