SYNOPSIS

Requires Higher Education Student Assistance Authority to issue vouchers in amount of monthly loan repayment amount for loan borrowers who have child enrolled in Grow NJ Kids-rated child care program.

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AN ACT concerning student loan repayment ¹[waivers] vouchers¹ for 1 certain borrowers and supplementing chapter 71C of Title 18A of 2 3 the New Jersey Statutes. 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 1. As used in this act: 9 "Approved program" means a licensed child care center, a 10 school- or center-based preschool program, a Head Start program, 11 or a registered family child care provider which has achieved a 12 Grow NJ Kids rating of at least three. "Authority" means the Higher Education Student Assistance 13 Authority" established pursuant to N.J.S.18A:71A-3. 14 "Grow NJ Kids" means New Jersey's quality rating improvement 15 16 system designed to raise the quality of child care and early learning 17 programs. "Program" means the Grow NJ Kids Student Loan ¹[Waiver] 18 Voucher¹ Program established pursuant to section 2 of this act. 19 "Program participant" means a ¹[New Jersey College Loans to 20 21 Assist State Students (NJCLASS) Loan Program] State or federal student aid loan program¹ borrower who has a child enrolled in an 22 approved program and who has applied and been accepted by the 23 24 authority for participation in the Grow NJ Kids Student Loan ¹[Waiver] <u>Voucher</u>¹ Program. 25 26 2. There is established a Grow NJ Kids Student Loan 27 28 ¹[Waiver] <u>Voucher</u>¹ Program within the Higher Education Student Assistance Authority. Under the program, the authority shall 29 ¹[reduce] <u>issue a voucher to an eligible borrower in the amount of</u>¹ 30 the principal monthly loan repayment amount for an eligible ¹[New 31 Jersey College Loans to Assist State Students (NJCLASS) Loan 32 Program]¹ borrower who has a child enrolled in an approved 33 program ¹[, by the amount of the approved program's monthly 34 35 tuition. The borrower shall pay any principal monthly loan repayment amount that exceeds the amount waived by the authority 36 plus any interest]¹. The State shall appropriate such amounts as 37 may be necessary to offset the loan principal amounts ¹[waived] 38 provided through the vouchers authorized¹ under the program. 39 40 3. To be eligible to participate in the program, an applicant 41 shall: 42 43 be a resident of the State; a. 44 provide evidence of his child's enrollment in an approved b. 45 program;

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c. submit an application to participate in the program to the 1 2 authority in a time and manner as determined by the authority; 3 ¹[and]¹ d. ¹have an individual annual income of no greater than \$75,000 4 or a combined household income of no greater than \$150,000; and 5 e.¹ satisfy any additional criteria the authority may establish. 6 7 8 4. a. A program participant shall enter into a contract with the 9 authority. The contract shall specify the amount of the monthly 10 ¹[loan repayment to be waived by the authority and the monthly amount] voucher¹ to be ¹[paid by the] issued to a¹ program 11 participant. 12 b. A program participant who has entered into a contract with 13 14 the authority may nullify the contract by notifying the authority in writing and assuming full responsibility for the total monthly loan 15 16 repayment amount. 17 18 5. A program participant shall immediately notify the authority 19 if: 20 there is a change in the tuition amount charged by the a. 21 approved program; 22 b. the child is no longer enrolled in the approved program; or 23 c. the child transfers from the approved program to another 24 approved program, or to another child care program that does not 25 have a Grow NJ Kids rating of at least three. 26 27 6. The authority shall provide: each licensed child care center, school- or center-based 28 a. preschool program, Head Start program, or registered family child 29 30 care provider with information on the Grow NJ Kids ¹[initiative, including information on how to attain a Grow NJ Kids rating] 31 Student Loan Voucher Program¹; and 32 33 ¹[each NJCLASS Loan Program borrower with information on b. 34 the Grow NJ Kids Student Loan Waiver Program **]** information on the 35 Grow NJ Kids Student Loan Voucher Program to the general public 36 through the authority's website and through other relevant outreach to 37 loan borrowers as determined by the authority¹. 38 ¹7. An approved program shall publicize the Grow NJ Kids 39 Student Loan Voucher Program within their facility, on their 40 41 websites, and through any other relevant communications to 42 individuals, as deemed appropriate by the approved program.¹ 43 The authority shall adopt in accordance with the 44 ¹[7.] 8.¹ "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et 45

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- 1 seq.), rules and regulations as may be necessary to implement the
- 2 provisions of this act.
