AN ACT directing the State Auditor to conduct performance review 1 2 audits of the public institutions of higher education. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. a. The State Auditor is directed to conduct a performance 8 review audit of each public institution of higher education. For each institution, the performance review audit shall include, but 9 10 need not be limited to: (1) an analysis of the prevalence, cost, and quality of online 11 12 courses offered by the institution; 13 (2) a review of the remedial courses offered by the institution 14 and the effectiveness of those courses in preparing students for 15 credit-bearing courses; (3) a review of the fees charged by the institution, the 16 17 appropriate level of those fees, and whether fees are being used by 18 the institution as a mechanism to artificially deflate required tuition 19 costs: (4) an analysis of the market value of the degrees offered by the 20 institution compared to the costs associated with earning that 21 22 degree; and 23 (5) a review of the four-year and six-year graduation rates in the case of students enrolled in a four-year baccalaureate degree 24 program, and of the two-year and three-year graduation rates for 25 26 students enrolled in a two-year associate degree program, to determine the extent and causes of low graduation rates at the 27 28 institution. 29 The institutions of higher education to receive a performance b. review audit shall be Rutgers, the State University; Rowan 30 University; the New Jersey Institute of Technology; Montclair State 31 32 University; the State colleges and universities established pursuant 33 to chapter 64 of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes; and the 34 county colleges. 35 36 Within one year of the effective date of this act, the State 2. 37 Auditor shall submit a report to the Governor, and to the Legislature 38 pursuant to section 2 of P.L.1991, c.164 (C.52:14-19.1), on the 39 results of the performance review audits conducted pursuant to section 1 of this act. 40 41 42 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 43 44 **STATEMENT** 45 46 This bill directs the State Auditor to conduct a performance review audit of each New Jersey public institution of higher 47 education.
