**SYNOPSIS**

Requires public water systems to compile, and submit to DEP, lead service line inventories.

**CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT**

2 required to develop, and publish on its Internet website, a guidance  
3 document, based on industry best practices, to assist public water  
4 systems in compiling the lead service line inventories required by  
5 the bill. Finally, within 24 months after the effective date of the  
6 bill, the DEP would be required to submit a report to the Governor  
7 and the Legislature assessing the extent of lead service lines in the  
8 State and recommending new policies to address the public health  
9 hazards posed by lead service lines.
